Running Order & Ring Size

Judging will begin at 8:00 am each day. Trial hours are 7:00 am—7:00 pm
Rings will be outside on grass and measure 100 x 100. In the case of inclement weather the rings will be moved to Lyttle Cow Palace, under cover on dirt, and the start time will be noon, Monday only. Tuesday will start at 8:00 am. Electronic timers will be used each day. Standard Ring: Excellent, Open, Novice JWW Ring : Excellent, Open, Novice

Class Information and Obstacles

Classes offered: Regular Titling: Novice A & B, Open, Excellent A & B for Standard and JWW. Preferred: Novice, Open, Excellent A & B for both Standard and JWW. Owners are responsible for entering the proper class. Complete rules can be found on the AKC website at www.akc.org. For a copy of the rule book write to: American Kennel Club, 5580 Centerview Dr., Raleigh, NC 27606-3390. To place a credit card order by telephone call: 919-233-9767 voice and 919-816-3627 fax. Minimum order is \$10. Obstacles will conform to the current edition of the AKC Regulations for Agility trials.

Course Familiarization / Warm-ups

Handlers in all classes are permitted to walk the course, without a dog, prior to the start of a class. A warm-up jump will be provided for each ring.

Move-Up Regulations

Dogs may be moved up to a higher class at the request of the owner, as a result of qualifying for an agility title, provided that the request is received in writing by the Trial Secretary, no later than 6 pm PST on the Monday preceding the event. Day to day move ups are allowed providing the Trial Secretary is notified at the show site in writing within 15 minutes of the last dog completing the course.

**Tri-umph's Turning Hearts CDX, MX, MXJ, MAD
Memorial Challenge Trophy**

This trophy, in memory of "Poppy," is awarded annually at the Pembroke Welsh Corgi Club of America Agility Trials. It will be awarded to the Highest Combined Scoring Pembroke Welsh Corgi that qualifies from the Excellent Standard and Excellent Jumpers with Weaves Regular classes (Preferred classes not eligible). Only qualifying runs will count. If more than one corgi has the same number of clean runs, the determining factor will be which one has the most combined seconds under standard course time. In the case of a tie, a run-off will be held at the judge's discretion.

The trophy is a bronze sculpture by artist Elizabeth Trail of "Poppy" doing the weave poles. It is mounted on a permanent base with a plate describing the trophy.

This trophy must be won three times by the same owner, not necessarily with the same corgi, before he/she may take permanent possession. The trophy will remain in the possession of the PWCCA Trophy Chairperson until won outright. A certificate, rosette and a 10" apple bowl will be awarded to the Pembroke Welsh Corgi that qualifies to win the Memorial Challenge this year.

This trophy was won by Jane Glier in 2001, 2004, and 2005. Instead of taking possession of the trophy, she generously donated it back to PWCCA.

Notice to Exhibitors

- This event is open to all AKC registered dogs 15 months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have obtained AKC ILP numbers, except bitches in season, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance. Refer to Chapter 2 of the Registration and Discipline rules for the listing of registrable breeds that may participate.
- Running order will be determined by random draw. Handlers with more than one dog in a class will have those dogs separated as much as possible.
- If a dog and/or handler are dismissed, regardless of the reason, there will be NO refund of entry fees.
- Full refund for bitches in season before the Monday preceding the event. 50% refund for bitches in season between Tuesday and Friday.
- Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused or barred from competition by action of the Trial Committee.
- No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.
- EXHIBITORS ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR COMPLETE, ACCURATE, AND LEGIBLE INFORMATION ON THEIR ENTRY FORMS; ILLEGIBLE OR INCOMPLETE EINTRIES CANNOT BE ENTERED IN THE TRIAL.
- It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and /or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and /or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Trial Committee, be asked to leave the trial site. In such case, no refund on any fees paid will be made.
- All dogs must be on leash at all times except when in the ring or when in the designated agility warm-up area.
- Exhibitors are responsible for being at the ring gate when it is their turn to run.
- Please be courteous and pick up after your dog.
- Exhibitors, while competing, must wear proper footwear. Exhibitors will not be allowed to compete in "bare" feet or open toe shoes.
- Dogs under six months of age are prohibited at AKC Agility Trials
- Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations. Rabies vaccine is required in the State of California.

Directions:

AGREEMENT

I (we) agree that the club holding this event has the right to refuse this entry for cause which the club shall deem sufficient. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog.

Additionally, I (we) hereby assume the sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify, defend and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expense (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damage because of bodily injuries, including death at any time resulting therefrom, sustained by any person or persons, including myself (ourselves), or on account of damage to property, arising out of or in consequence of my (our) participation in this event, however such, injuries, death or property damage may be caused, and whether or not the same may have been caused or may be alleged to have been caused by the negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees, agents, or any other persons. INSTRUCTIONS

Handlers may opt to enter in a higher height division for all *Regular* titling classes, but not in a division lower than their proper height division.

Dogs entered in the *Preferred* classes must compete at the required jump height and may not compete in a jump height division higher or lower than their proper height division.

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an Agility Jump Height Card may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. The Judge's measurement will be valid for this trial or *back-to-back trials* only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.
