**Awards**

Green ribbons will be awarded to all dogs with qualifying scores. Rosettes will be awarded to Excellent B dogs who qualify in Standard and JWW on the same day.

**Judging will begin each day at 8:00 am**

Standard Ring: Open, Excellent, Novice Standard classes followed by Excellent FAST  
JWW Ring: Excellent, Open, Novice JWW classes followed by Open FAST, Novice FAST  
FAST will run last in both rings on Saturday and first on Sunday.

**Class Information, Jump Heights, Scoring**

Handlers may opt to enter in a higher height division for all *Regular* titling classes and the FAST titling classes, but not in a division lower than their proper height division.

**Dogs entered in the *Preferred* classes must compete at the required jump height and may not compete in a jump height higher or lower than their proper height division.**

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an Agility Jump Height Card may still compete; however, thy must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. The Judge's measurement will be valid for this trial or *back-to-back trials* only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.

### Move-Up Regulations

Dogs may be moved up to a higher class at the request of the owner, as a result of qualifying for an agility title, provided that the request in received in writing by the Trial Secretary, no later than 6 pm on the Monday preceding the event. Sunday move ups will be allowed provided that the request is received in writing by the Trial Secretary no later than 15 minutes after the last dog has crossed the finish line on Saturday.

Notice to Exhibitors

- This event is open to all AKC registered dogs 15 months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have obtained AKC ILP numbers, except bitches in season, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance. Refer to Chapter 2 of the Registration and Discipline rules for the listing of registrable breeds that may participate. Running order will be determined by random draw. Handlers with more than one dog in a class will have those dogs separated as much as possible. If a dog and/or handler are dismissed, regardless of the reason, there will be NO refund of entry fees. 50% refund for bitches in season after the closing date and up to the Friday before the event. Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused or barred from competition by action of the Trial Committee. No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee. EXHIBITORS ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR COMPLETE, ACCURATE, AND LEGIBLE INFORMATION ON THEIR ENTRY FORMS; ILLEGIBLE OR INCOMPLETE ENTRIES CANNOT BE ENTERED IN THE TRIAL. It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and /or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and /or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Trial Committee, be asked to leave the trial site. In such case, no refund on any fees paid will be made. All dogs must be on leash at all times except when in the ring or when in the designated agility warm-up area. Exhibitors are responsible for being at the ring gate when it is their turn to run. Please be courteous and pick up after your dog. Exhibitors, while competing must wear proper footwear. Exhibitors will not be allowed to compete in "bare" feet or open toe shoes. Dogs under six months of age are prohibited at AKC Agility Trials. Exhibitors should follow their veterinarian's recommendations to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases and have appropriate vaccinations. Rabies vaccine is required in the State of California.
