Preliminary running order contingent on move-up entries not yet received. Exhibitors shall be provided armbands or stickers indicating their dog's running order number for this trial. **Per AKC rules, the move up deadline is 6 pm on Monday, April 30, 2007.** Absolutely no move ups for Saturday will be allowed after this time and date. Move ups for Sunday must be given to the Trial Secretary, at the show site, in writing within 15 minutes of the last dog completing the course.

On Saturday, Mensona KC is holding a B-OB Conformation Match. County Wide DTC is holding an Obedience and Rally workshop. Rings for these events will be on the same large grass area as the agility rings. Please respect their areas.

Sonoma County Fairgrounds

Directions:

Take highway 101 to Santa Rosa. Exit onto highway 12 eastbound towards Sonoma. Exit highway 12 at the South E Street/Downtown exit. Upon reaching the surface street, Bennett Valley Road, you will come to a stoplight and just in front of you on your right will be the Sonoma County Fairgrounds.

If you are coming by highway 12 westbound, take the Downtown exit, and turn left at the stop light. This will lead you to the entrance to the Sonoma County Fair.

The rings will be outdoors on grass and measure 100' x 100'. Bring cover for sun and rain. Food and beverages will be available for purchase on site.

Parking is available in the Brookwood lot across the street from the fairgrounds or under the freeway. Unloading and loading in the Brookwood lot across the street from the fairgrounds or under the freeway.

Overnight Parking

Overnight vehicles may park on the grass around the ring area – unless it rains the week before the event. In case of rain be prepared to park along the curb and run extension cords to the power pedestals. Enter through back gate near the horse barns.

Judging Schedule

Novice and Excellent B&A Standard, JWW and FAST classes will run together by jump heights with division B running before division A. The preferred classes will run intermingled with the regular classes by height. Each class will be briefed separately. Lunch breaks will be at the Judge's discretion. A warm-up area, consisting of a regulation agility jump will be provided for all exhibitors.

Walk through: will begin as soon as the Judge has approved the course. This will be at approximately 7:30 am. Novice and Open – all heights will walk the course together prior to their class being judged. The Excellent class may be split by height at the discretion of the judge and show committee.

Beverly Morgan Lewis will judge all Novice and Open level classes both days. Steve Herwig will judge all Excellent level classes both days. An AKC representative will be in attendance both days. Judging will begin each day at 8:00 am. Check in will begin at 7:00 am. Dogs that do not have an AKC height card must either: be measured or present a height card or measurement receipt at check-in. Measurement of dogs without height cards will be at approximately 7:30 am each day and in between classes as time allows.

Dogs will be judged as follows: from the lowest number in each class to the highest number.

The jump height on Saturday will be: 26, 24, 20, 16, 12, 8, 4

The jump height on Sunday will be: 4, 8, 12, 16, 20, 24, 26
