No set ups before 3 pm. Anyone setting up canopies, staking off space or claiming RV spaces before 3 pm will be asked to cease and remove their belongings. Barbara Avila will be onsite to ensure the show committee is able to set up the show *before* exhibitors begin claiming space. Please follow their directions as they are acting on behalf of the show committee. Both rings will be on the South Lawn. Only RVs may park by the cinder block wall on the south end of the fairgrounds.
The Sacramento Valley Shetland Sheepdog Club is hosting conformation and obedience on either the North Lawn or the Pole Barn. Please take care not to intrude in their area.

Preliminary running order contingent on move-up entries not yet received. Exhibitors shall be provided armbands or stickers indicating their dog's running order number for this trial. **Per AKC rules, the move up deadline is 6 pm on Monday, March 19, 2007.** Absolutely no move ups for Saturday will be allowed after this time and date. Move ups for Sunday must be given to the Trial Secretary, at the show site, in writing within 15 minutes of the last dog completing the course.

Novice and Excellent B&A Standard, JWW and FAST classes will run together by jump heights with division B running before division A. The preferred classes will run intermingled with the regular classes by height. Each class will be briefed separately. Lunch breaks will be at the Judge's discretion. A warm-up area, consisting of a regulation agility jump will be provided for all exhibitors.

Walk through: will begin as soon as the Judge has approved the course. This will be at approximately 7:30 am. Novice and Open – all heights will walk the course together prior to their class being judged. The Excellent class will be split by height at the discretion of the judge and show committee.

Judging will begin each day at 8:00 am. Check in will begin at 7:00 am.

Dogs that do not have an AKC height card or who have not provided a copy of their height card to the trial secretary must either be measured or present a height card at check-in. Measurement of dogs without height cards will be as follows:

Excellent level dogs: 7:30 am each day. – Robert Long

Open and Novice level dogs: 10:00 – 10:15 am or 11:00 – 11:15 am or noon – 12:15. Cindy Macklin

Dixon May Fairgrounds

The rings will be outdoors on grass and measure 100' x 120'. Bring cover for sun and rain. No parking is allowed on Dixon Blvd. Saturday and Sunday morning you may drive in to unload. All vehicles must be moved to the regular parking lot, behind the red fence or across the street, by 7:30 am. **Absolutely no vehicles may drive in to load or unload either day while the rings are running.** Only RVs may park by the cinder block wall on the south end of the fairgrounds.

Food and beverages will be available for purchase from Dannie's Catering.

Directions:

From I-80 west in Dixon:

Take 113 South towards Dixon.

From I-80 east, take the Dixon Ave/A Street exit and go right on A Street. Turn right on First Street. The fairgrounds are 3 blocks south on your left side. Go past the office/main entrance drive and turn left into the south end of the fairgrounds.

Directions: Take I-80 towards Sacramento. Take 113 north towards Woodland. Take the first exit (Hutchison Drive) and bear right (east) on Hutchison Drive. Turn right at the first stop light (LaRue Road). Follow LaRue Road to the first right turn (Garrod Drive). Follow Garrod Drive to the stop sign. After stopping, proceed directly ahead. The client parking lot entrance is on your right. Client parking is free as long as you park in a designated patient parking space. Client parking cannot accommodate vehicles that require more space than a passenger car. There are three different reception stations and it is important to come to the station mentioned when you made your appointment. Reception station 3 is in the building on your left as you drive

toward the parking lot and reception stations 1 and 2 are in the main hospital building which is to the west of the parking lot. Drive time approximately 15 minutes.
