NOTE: A Recording Fee of \$.50 and \$1.50 Event Service Fee and \$3 Rally Fee will be required for each dog entered at any Licensed or Member Club Show, Obedience Trial, Rally or Tracking Test. This Recording Fee and Event Service Fee is to be collected by the Show-giving Club and paid to the American Kennel Club. Unloading & Parking Information

Unloading Friday is through Gate 12 off Valley Avenue only. Proceed straight ahead, at end of roadway make a right and go through the tunnel. **Parking: after unloading return your vehicle to the grass parking lot. Unloading Saturday, Sunday and Monday** is through both the Main Gate off Pleasanton Ave and Gate 12 off Valley Ave. Any exhibitor may drive onto grounds to unload between 6:00 am and 7:15 am. All vehicles must be off the grounds by 7:30 am or they will be towed. Be sure to allow yourself plenty of time and for safety reasons this time cannot be extended. Except for a medical emergency, no vehicle may drive onto the show grounds after 7:15 am. You may drive back in to load up only after all judging in your area has concluded. After 7:15 am an unloading loop will be open all day between the Young California and Exhibition Buildings and through the tunnel in the back for the North Forty rings.

Del Valle Weekend RV Parking Information

All RV parking is through Gate 12 off Valley Avenue. Make a right after passing the Watch & Wager Building and follow the signs. Do not proceed to your RV parking space without an escort. All vehicles must have a working fire extinguisher, be self-contained, no discharging of gray water allowed. Electrical hookups not guaranteed—no electrical cords permitted across paths or roadways. Persons who break open locked boxes or otherwise damage property in order to find electricity will be held responsible for damage and may be asked to leave. No running of generators after 11 pm or before 5 am. Those wishing to park together must send reservations in together, however there is no guarantee that we can accommodate all requests. All parking is at your own risk. Alameda Co. Fair Assn. & Del Valle Dog Club assume no responsibility for fire, theft and/or loss to vehicles or their contents. DVDC reserves the right to withdraw parking privileges, without return of parking or entry fees, from anyone who cannot abide by these rules or who resorts to abusive language or actions. Violators may be subject to Bench Show Committee charges. \$45 per night for 20' x 40' space; \$55 for 20' x 60', \$65 for 20' x 80' space. Vehicles over 40' in length will be accommodated only where possible. Trailers and tow units may be required to be unhitched. Tagalong vehicles are not permitted. Shower location shown on ring map: open 6 am to 9 am and 5 pm to 8 pm people only, no dogs! Fiberglass dog baths have been placed around the show grounds, please check ring map for locations. Dog bathing is restricted to these dog bathtubs only.

Reserved Overnight parking Thursday 2 pm to 11 pm, Friday 4:30 pm to 11 pm. Saturday and Sunday 6 am to 7:15 am and 5 pm to 11 pm. Monday 6 am to 7:15 am only. If you arrive in your RV at other times please park in the exhibitor parking lots and you may move to your reserved space only during the aforementioned hours. **Unreserved Overnight parking in large paved lots is \$40 per night.**

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS REGARDING CORRECTION OR CHANGES TO ENTRIES: The specific changes listed in Chapter 11, Section 6 (i.e. sex of dog, transfers between age specific regular classes and "move-ups" to BOV or BOB) of the Dog Show Rules are the only changes to the entries superintendents or secretaries are authorized to make *after closing of entries*. **THIS RULE IS STRICTLY ENFORCED BY THE AMERICAN KENNEL CLUB. PLEASE CHECK YOUR ENTRIES CAREFULLY.** Corrections to entries may be made by the Superintendent prior to the closing of entries if such correction is submitted in writing. NON-REGULAR CLASSES INVOLVING SINGLE DOG ENTRIES

(The winners of these Classes will be eligible to compete for Best of Breed)

*Veteran Dogs Veteran Bitches

A Class for Dogs and a Class for Bitches. The Veterans Classes shall be for any dog or bitch 7 years of age or older. *Chapter 11, Section 8: of the "Rules Applying to Dog Shows" provides that a neutered male may be entered as a Veteran Dog in the Veteran Dog Class and a spayed bitch may be entered as a Veteran Bitch in the Veteran Bitch Class.

NON-REGULAR CLASSES INVOLVING MULTIPLE DOG ENTRIES

(The winners of these Classes will NOT be eligible to compete for Best of Breed)

* **Stud Dog Class**—For Stud with two Get and no more than four Get. Stud Dogs must be entered in the Stud Dog Class and must be shown in the ring with their Get. The owner of the Stud Dog need not necessarily be owner of the Get. While the merits of the Stud Dog are not to be considered in the placement of the entry, the Stud Dog must be examined to determine if it has a condition that would require its disqualification or excusal under the Dog Show Rules, AKC Policy, or the standard for its breed. The Get only will be judged based on their merits. Get must be entered and shown in a Regular or Non-Regular Class. User the space for "Additional Entry".

* **Brood Bitch Class**— Same as for the Stud Dog except substitute Brood Bitch for Stud Dog and Produce for Get.

*Chapter 11, Section 8: of the "Rules Applying to Dog Shows" provides that a castrated male may be entered as a Stud Dog in the Stud Dog Class and a spayed bitch may be entered as a Brood Bitch in the Brood Bitch Class.

Brace—For two Rottweilers (a unit), irrespective of sex with at least one common owner and shown in the ring with no more than two handlers. Dogs may or may not be entered in a Regular or Non-Regular Class, but if not, must pay a separate Entry Fee. Use space for "Additional Entry".

Pre-Novice Class—For dogs capable of performing Novice Obedience exercises to gain competitive experience. The Pre-Novice class shall be for dogs that have not received a third qualifying score in a Novice Class prior to the closing of the trial. All exercises will be scored as in the Novice Class, except the dogs will perform all exercises on leash, which should be long enough to provide adequate slack.

Graduate Novice—For dogs that have not been certified by a judge to receive a third qualifying score towards a CDX title prior to the closing of entries. Dogs entered in Graduate novice if eligible under the Obedience Regulations, may also be entered in any other obedience classes.

Veterans— For dogs that have an obedience title and are 7 years or older on the day of the trial. The exercises shall be performed and judged as in the Novice Class. Dogs may also be entered in another class or classes.

Brace—For two dogs capable of performing the Novice exercises. Dogs need not be owned by the same person, but must be handled by one handler. A separate entry form must be completed for each dog comprising the Brace with a single entry fee.

SHOW LIMITS

The Jockeys, trainers and horse owners have asked that no exhibitors or dogs be allowed by horse stables, race track or horse exercise areas. It frightens their animals. Please abide by their wishes.

GENERAL INFORMATION AND SHOW RULES

CLOSING DATE FOR ENTRIES is 6:00 pm (P.D.T.), Wednesday, October 1, 2008 after which time entries cannot be accepted, canceled or changed, "except as provided for in Chapter 11, Section 6 of the Dog Show Rules".

POST DATED AND RETURNED CHECKS do not constitute a valid entry fee. The Show Secretary will add a collection fee to the amount of each returned check. The returned check **MUST BE MADE GOOD** by cash or money order **BEFORE** the dog(s) will be allowed in the ring. Any person that issues a check that is returned for non-payment, will be required to pay a fine of \$25 per check and all items for which check or checks were issued shall then be paid by cash, money order or cashier's check.

CONDITIONAL, UNSIGNED, INCOMPLETE, or entries received without fees will not be accepted.

OWNERS ARE RESPONSIBLE for errors on entry blanks and for entering the same dog twice. No refunds for duplicate entries.

ENTRIES NOT ON OFFICIAL AKC FORMS or photocopies of entry forms without rules and agreement on reverse side of Official AKC entry form are NOT acceptable.

CHANGES, ADDITIONS OR CORRECTIONS to entry forms must be received in writing prior to the close of entries. Those received by telephone are not acceptable.

TO BE ACCEPTABLE an entry must be submitted with required entry fee on an Official American Kennel Club entry form. Entries submitted in the form of telegrams or by telephone, cannot be accepted.

FACSIMILE MACHINE ENTRIES for this show will be accepted up to closing time. You will be billed through Paypal. A service fee of \$5 per dog will be charged. You must include the front and back of the entry form..

ENTRY FEES SHALL NOT BE REFUNDED in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by the Judge, or barred from competition by action of the show committee, or because the dog is ineligible to compete due to being entered incorrectly. There is no refund of entry fee for duplicate entry or overpayment of entry fees. If because of riots, civil disturbances, fire, extreme and/or dangerous weather conditions, an Act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, strikes or any other acts beyond the control of the Club or Show Secretary it is impossible to open or complete the show, no refund of entry fee will be made.

AN ADMINSISTRATIVE FEE will be charged for all cancellations or changes made prior to closing of entries. Because of the cost of processing, no refunds under \$10 will be made.

ONLY DOGS THAT ARE ELIGIBLE to be shown under the American Kennel Club rules shall be allowed within the show precincts.

ALL DOGS SHALL BE kept on leash except when in the exercising or obedience ring.

THERE SHALL BE NO drilling nor intensive or corrective training of dogs on the show grounds or premises.

DOGS MUST BE READY FOR JUDGING. The Club and its Show Secretary will not be responsible and are not obligated to furnish any service for notifying exhibitors or their agents of breed or class judging. Judges will not wait for any dog holding up a class. Owners or agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging ring.

DOGS NEED TO BE AT THE SHOW only at scheduled time of judging and may leave immediately thereafter, unless required for further judging.

THE CLUB reserves the right to substitute a prize of equal or greater value.

ALL TROPHIES must be claimed the day of the show. None will be mailed or otherwise distributed.

CLASS CASH PRIZES will be paid in the ring to the person showing the dog. Claims for prize money must be made in the ring before the judging is over and the Show Secretary Office is advised at once. The Show Secretary and Show giving club disclaim any liability for cash prizes after the judging of the class is over.

THE WELFARE OF AN EXHIBITOR'S CHILD is assumed to be the responsibility of the exhibitor. It is distinctly understood that exhibitors will exercise control and restraint over their children on the days of the shows.
