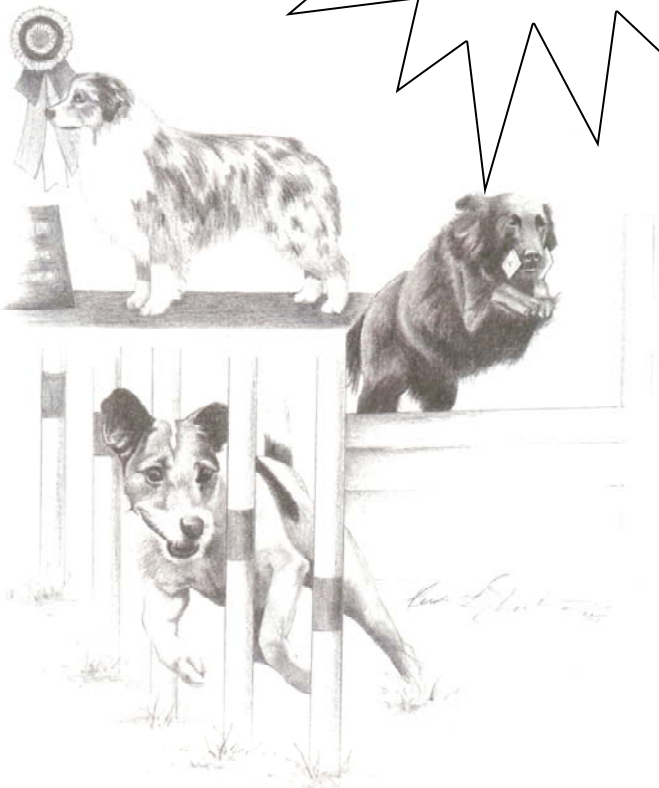

Del Valle Weekend RV Parking Information

All RV parking is through Gate 12 off Valley Avenue. Make a right after passing the Watch & Wager Building and follow the signs. Do not proceed to your RV parking space without an escort. All vehicles must have a working fire extinguisher, be self-contained, no discharging of gray water allowed. Electrical hookups not guaranteed—no electrical cords permitted across paths or roadways. Persons who break open locked boxes or otherwise damage property in order to find electricity will be held responsible for damage and may be asked to leave. No running of generators after 11 pm or before 6 am. Those wishing to park together must send reservations in together, however there is no guarantee that we can accommodate all requests. All parking is at your own risk. Alameda Co. Fair Assn. & Del Valle Dog Club assume no responsibility for fire, theft and/or loss to vehicles or their contents. DVDC reserves the right to withdraw parking privileges, without return of parking or entry fees, from anyone who cannot abide by these rules or who resorts to abusive language or actions. Violators may be subject to Bench Show Committee charges. \$40 per night for 20' x 40' space; \$50 for 20' x 60', \$65 for 20' x 80' space. Vehicles over 40' in length will be accommodated only where possible. Trailers and tow units may be required to be unhitched. Tagalong vehicles are \$30 per night. Shower location shown on ring map; open 6 am to 9 am and 5 pm to 8 pm people only, no dogs! Fiberglass dog baths have been placed around the show grounds, please check ring map for locations. Dog bathing is restricted to these dog bathtubs only.

Reserved Overnight parking Thursday 2 pm to 11 pm, Friday 4:30 pm to 11 pm. Saturday and Sunday 6 am to 7:15 am and 5 pm to 11 pm. Monday 6 am to 7:15 am only. If you arrive in your RV at other times please park in the exhibitor parking lots and you may move to your reserved space only during the aforementioned hours.

Notice to Exhibitors

- This event is open to all AKC registered dogs 15 months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have obtained AKC ILP/PAL numbers, except bitches in season, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance. Refer to Chapter 2 of the Registration and Discipline rules for the listing of registrable breeds that may participate.
- Running order will be determined by random draw. Handlers with more than one dog in a class will have those dogs separated as much as possible.
- If a dog and/or handler are dismissed, regardless of the reason, there will be NO refund of entry fees.
- 50% refund for bitches in season after the closing date and up to the Friday before the event.
- Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused or barred from competition by action of the Trial Committee.
- No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.
- EXHIBITORS ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR COMPLETE, ACCURATE, AND LEGIBLE INFORMATION ON THEIR ENTRY FORMS; ILLEGIBLE OR INCOMPLETE ENTRIES CANNOT BE ENTERED IN THE TRIAL.
- It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and /or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and /or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Trial Committee, be asked to leave the trial site. In such case, no refund on any fees paid will be made.
- All dogs must be on leash at all times except when in the ring or when in the designated agility warm-up area.
- Exhibitors are responsible for being at the ring gate when it is their turn to run.
- Please be courteous and pick up after your dog.
- Exhibitors, while competing must wear proper footwear. Exhibitors will not be allowed to compete in "bare" feet or open toe shoes.
- No smoking in buildings or arena.
- Dogs under six months of age are prohibited at AKC Agility Trials.
- Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendations to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations. Rabies vaccine is required in the State of California.

Unloading & Parking Information

Unloading Friday is through Gate 12 off Valley Avenue only. Rings will be located near the golf driving range. **Parking: after unloading return your vehicle to the grass parking lot. Unloading Saturday, Sunday and Monday** is through both the Main Gate off Pleasanton Ave and Gate 12 off Valley Ave. Any exhibitor may drive onto grounds to unload between 6:00 am and 7:15 am. All vehicles must be off the grounds by 7:30 am or they will be towed. Be sure to allow yourself plenty of time and for safety reasons this time cannot be extended. Except for a medical emergency, no vehicle may drive onto the show grounds after 7:15 am. You may drive back in to load up only after all judging in your area has concluded. After 7:15 am an unloading loop will be open all day between the Young California and Exhibition Buildings and through the tunnel in the back for the North Forty rings.

Class Information and Obstacles

Classes offered: Regular Titling: Novice A & B, Open, Excellent A & B for Standard, JWW and FAST. Preferred: Novice, Open, Excellent A & B for Standard, JWW and FAST. Owners are responsible for entering the proper class. Complete rules can be found on the AKC website at www.akc.org. For a copy of the rule book write to: American Kennel Club, 5580 Centerview Dr., Raleigh, NC 27606-3390. To place a credit card order by telephone call: 919-233-9767 voice and 919-816-3627 fax. Minimum order is \$10. Obstacles will conform to the current edition of the AKC Regulations for Agility Trials.

Awards

Flat ribbons will be awarded 1st—4th place in each jump height class to dogs earning a qualifying score. Green ribbons will be awarded to all dogs earning a qualifying score. Rosettes will be awarded to dogs finishing a title. Rosettes will be awarded to Ex B Std/JWW dogs earning a Double Q. MACH Rosette will be awarded to all dogs earning the MACH title.

Move-Up Regulations

Dogs may be moved up to a higher class at the request of the owner, as a result of qualifying for an agility title, provided that the request is received in writing by the Trial Secretary, no later than 6 pm on the Monday preceding the event. Sunday move ups will be allowed provided that the request is received in writing by the Trial Secretary, at the show site, no later than 15 minutes after the last dog has crossed the finish line on Saturday.

Course Familiarization/Warm-ups

Handlers in all classes are permitted to walk the course, without a dog, prior to the start of a class. The walk through is restricted to handlers entered in that class. A warm-up jump will be provided for each ring.

AGREEMENT

Additionally, I (we) hereby assume the sold responsibility for and agree to indemnify, defend and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expense (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damage because of bodily injuries, including death at any time resulting therefrom, sustained by any person or persons, including myself (ourselves), or on account of damage to property, arising out of or in consequence of my (our) participation in this event, however such injuries, death or property damage may be caused, and whether or not the same may have been caused or may be alleged to have been caused by the negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees, agents, or any other persons. INSTRUCTIONS

Handlers may opt to enter in a higher height division for all *Regular* titling classes and the FAST titling classes, but not in a division lower than their proper height division.

Dogs entered in the Preferred classes must compete at the required jump height and may not compete in a jump height higher or lower than their proper height division.

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an Agility Jump Height Card may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. The Judge's measurement will be valid for this trial or *back-to-back trials* only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.
