Dixon May Fairgrounds – Outdoors on grass
655 South First St., Dixon, CA 95620

No set ups before 3 pm. Anyone setting up canopies, staking off space or claiming RV spaces prior to 3 pm, and this includes parking next to the perfect spot under the trees and using your vehicle to save your space, will be asked to move behind the red fence until 3 pm. Rings will be on both the North and South lawns.

Special Notice: On Saturday the Sacramento Valley Shetland Sheepdog club will host a conformation and obedience match on the North Lawn. The rings will be near and north of the restrooms.

BYO – travel mug, sports bottle, drinking glass, coffee cup. SSCNC is Going Green. Purified drinking water will be provided for workers at each ring and near the score table. The water will be in Igloo containers. Bring your own drinking cup.

Back by Popular Demand - Look for Katy Robertson and Barbara Brown near the score table to create your own dog crate name tag. Katy will have stickers, construction paper, scissors, the call name of every dog entered pre-printed and a laminating machine. If you bring a photo of your dog it can be incorporated into the tag. The maximum photo size is 3 ½ x 2 ¼ (business card size). Photos can be trimmed at the site.

Dixon May Fairgrounds

The rings will be outdoors on grass and measure 100' x 120'. Bring cover for sun and rain. No parking is allowed on Dixon Blvd. Saturday and Sunday morning you may drive in to unload. All vehicles must be moved to the regular parking lot, behind the red fence or across the street, by 7:30 am. **Absolutely no vehicles may drive in to load or unload either day while the rings are running.** Only RVs may park by the cinder block wall on the south end of the fairgrounds.

Food and beverages will be available for purchase from Dannie's Catering.

Directions:

From I-80 west in Dixon:

Take 113 South towards Dixon.

From I-80 east, take the Dixon Ave/A Street exit and go right on A Street. Turn right on First Street. The fairgrounds are 3 blocks south on your left side. Go past the office/main entrance drive and turn left into the south end of the fairgrounds.

Directions: Take I-80 towards Sacramento. Take 113 north towards Woodland. Take the first exit (Hutchison Drive) and bear right (east) on Hutchison Drive. Turn right at the first stop light (LaRue Road). Follow LaRue Road to the first right turn (Garrod Drive). Follow Garrod Drive to the stop sign. After stopping, proceed directly ahead. The client parking lot entrance is on your right. Client parking is free as long as you park in a designated patient parking space. Client parking cannot accommodate vehicles that require more space than a passenger car. There are three different reception stations and it is important to come to the station mentioned when you made your appointment. Reception station 3 is in the building on your left as you drive toward the parking lot and reception stations 1 and 2 are in the main hospital building which is to the west of the parking lot. Drive time approximately 15 minutes.

Preliminary running order contingent on move-up entries not yet received. Exhibitors shall be provided armbands or stickers indicating their dog's running order number for this trial. **Per AKC rules, the move up deadline is 6 pm on Monday, June 23, 2008.** Absolutely no move ups for Saturday will be allowed after this time and date. Move ups for Sunday must be given to the Trial Secretary, at the show site, in writing within 15 minutes of the last dog completing the course.

Height Cards and Measuring

All dogs, regardless of jump height must either: present a height card at check, send a copy of their height card with entry to this show, or be measured. Dogs that do not have an AKC height card or who have not provided a copy of their height card to the trial secretary must be measured BEFORE their first run of the weekend.

Measurement of dogs will take place near the score table at approximately 7:30 am each day. Both judges, Larry Brockett and Ann McQuillen will measure for cards.

Judging Schedule

Judging will begin each day at 8:00 am. Check in will begin at 7:00 am.

Novice and Excellent B&A Standard, JWW and FAST classes will run together by jump heights with division B running before division A. The preferred classes will run intermingled with the regular classes by height. Each class will be briefed separately. Lunch breaks will be at the Judge's discretion. A warm-up area, consisting of a regulation agility jump will be provided for all exhibitors.

Walk through: will begin as soon as the Judge has approved the course. This will be at approximately 7:30 am. Novice and Open – all heights will walk the course together prior to their class being judged. The Excellent class will be split by height at the discretion of the judge and show committee.

Dogs will be judged as follows: from the lowest number in each class to the highest number.

The jump height on Saturday for Standard and JWW will be: 26, 24, 20, 4, 8, 12, 16

The jump height on Sunday for Standard and JWW will be: 16, 12, 8, 4, 26, 24, 20

FAST will run small to tall on Saturday and tall to tall on Sunday.

Ann McQuillen will judge all JWW class, Open & Novice FAST

Classes will run as follows:

Standard Ring: Open, Excellent, Novice, Excellent FAST

JWW Ring: Excellent, Open, Novice, Open FAST, Novice FAST

Sunday: 580 Runs

Larry Brockett will judge all JWW classes, Open & Novice FAST.

Ann McQuillen will judge all Standard classes, Excellent FAST.

Standard Ring: Excellent FAST, Open, Excellent, Novice

JWW Ring: Excellent, Open, Novice, Open FAST, Novice FAST
