Course Familiarization / Warm-ups

Handlers in all classes are permitted to walk the course, without a dog, prior to the start of a class. The walk through is restricted to handlers entered in the class. A warm-up jump will be provided for each ring.

Move-Up Regulations

Dogs may be moved up to a higher class at the request of the owner, as a result of qualifying for an agility title, provided that the request is received in writing by the Trial Secretary, no later than 6 m on the Monday preceding the event. Sunday move ups are allowed providing the Trial Secretary is notified at the show site, in writing, within 15 minutes after the last dog has crossed the finish line on Saturday.

Handlers may opt to enter in a higher height division for all *Regular* titling classes and the FAST titling classes, but not in a division lower than their proper height division.

Dogs entered in the Preferred classes must compete at the required jump height and may not compete in a jump height higher or lower than their proper height division.

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an Agility Jump Height Card may still compete; however, thy must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. The Judge's measurement will be valid for this trial or *back-to-back trials* only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.

The Limited Junior Agility Showmanship Competition California Junior Handlers' of the Year

The California Junior Handlers' of the Year competition will be held at our Saturday Agility Trial March 8, 2008. Juniors may compete for the Scholarship award program only, not for legs toward future titles. They will compete in the class in which they earned their title.

Scoring: Standard, JWW and FAST will be counted with a combined score. The Junior Scholarship program will be one scholarship judged on the Excellent level classes. A Junior who might have more than one dog qualify, must pick only one class to run in for the Junior Handler of the Year competition. In the event that the Junior has another dog they wish to enter in the AKC trial on Saturday, they are allowed to do so if the second dog is running in a different class from the Junior Handler competition. Clean run time will be based on the percentage of Standard Course Time used, not the actual time of the dog. Faults will be scored 15 points for refusals, off courses and table faults. F's, or failure to perform will be charged 20 points per F. Over time faults will be charged 1 point for novice, 2 points for open and 3 points for excellent.

The Junior does not pay for the Junior Competition entry. They will be allowed to enter the regular agility trial on Sunday if they want, but are not allowed to compete in the regular AKC trial on Saturday with the dog they are running in the competition. The Junior Competition will be run after the regular agility class before the course is changed.

Limited Junior Agility Showmanship Competition

1. To be eligible to enter and compete, the Junior must be a California resident. Junior must have put an AKC Agility Title on the dog including January 1, 2007 and January 1, 2008. The Junior must have received the Standard Agility AKC Title Certificate from AKC and send a copy of the certificate with entry. Any Junior that has received three legs in excellent B standard or JWW in 2007 is also eligible to compete. They must send in copies of their Junior Handler Certification forms. In all cases, two of the three legs must be received from a California trial. Trials will include Licensed or Member Specialty Club Trials as well as Licensed or Member All-Breed Trials. Titles received from the Preferred Agility classes will not be eligible to compete.
2. A Junior Handler who will be 18 years old or older on the date of the trial may still compete provided he or she was less than 18 years of age on the date of the Standard title certificate earned.
3. Each dog handled in this class must be owned or co-owned by the Junior handler or the by the Junior's father, mother, brother, sister, uncle, aunt, grandmother or grandfather (including the corresponding half and step relations) or by a member of the Junior Handler's household and must be eligible to compete in AKC Agility Trials.

Notice to Exhibitors

- This event is open to all AKC registered dogs 15 months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have obtained AKC ILP numbers, except bitches in season, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance. Refer to Chapter 2 of the Registration and Discipline rules for the listing of registrable breeds that may participate.
- Running order will be determined by random draw. Handlers with more than one dog in a class will have those dogs separated as much as possible.
- If a dog and/or handler are dismissed, regardless of the reason, there will be NO refund of entry fees.
- 50% refund for bitches in season after closing date and up to the Thursday before the event.
- Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused or barred from competition by action of the Trial Committee.
- No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.
- EXHIBITORS ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR COMPLETE, ACCURATE, AND LEGIBLE INFORMATION ON THEIR ENTRY FORMS; ILLEGIBLE OR INCOMPLETE ENTRIES CANNOT BE ENTERED IN THE TRIAL.
