Awards

Ribbons will be awarded 1st—4th place in each jump height class to dog earning a qualifying score. Green ribbons will be awarded to all dogs with qualifying scores. QQ pins will be awarded to Excellent B dogs earning a Double Q. Each dog entered will receive a dog toy valued at \$2-\$4. High scoring Flat Coat Retriever each day will receive a voucher good for one free day at the 2010 Flat Coated Retriever All Breed Agility Trial. Single day free entry vouchers good for the 2010 event will be awarded to the high scoring dog in Novice, Open and Excellent each day. Any dog that qualifies in Excellent B standard and JWW all four days (8 clean runs) will receive a voucher for two entry days to the 2010 Flat Coated Retriever All Breed Agility Trial. Notify the Trial Secretary if you hope to finish a MACH at this event.

Course Familiarization/Warm-ups

Handlers in all classes are permitted to walk the course, without a dog, prior to the start of a class. No obstacle familiarization will be offered at this event. A warm-up jump will be provided for each ring.

Move-Up Regulations

Dogs may be moved up to a higher class at the request of the owner, as a result of qualifying for an agility title, provided that the request is received in writing by the Trial Secretary, no later than 6 pm on the Monday preceding the event. Saturday, Sunday and Monday move ups will be allowed provided that the request is received in writing by the Trial Secretary no later than 15 minutes after the last dog has crossed the finish line on Friday, Saturday and Sunday.

Worker Vouchers of \$2 per class will be offered to those who volunteer. The vouchers can be used toward entry fees at the 2010 show which will be held July 24—27. Workers will receive wonderful food in the hospitality room. We appreciate your help.

Notice to Exhibitors

- This event is open to all AKC registered dogs 15 months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have obtained AKC ILP/PAL numbers, except bitches in season, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance. Refer to Chapter 2 of the Registration and Discipline rules for the listing of registrable breeds that may participate.
- Running order will be determined by random draw. Handlers with more than one dog in a class will have those dogs separated as much as possible.
- If a dog and/or handler are dismissed, regardless of the reason, there will be NO refund of entry fees.
- 50% refund for bitches in season after the closing date and up to the Thursday before the event.
- Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused or barred from competition by action of the Trial Committee.
- No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.
- EXHIBITORS ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR COMPLETE, ACCURATE, AND LEGIBLE INFORMATION ON THEIR ENTRY FORMS; ILLEGIBLE OR INCOMPLETE ENTRIES CANNOT BE ENTERED IN THE TRIAL.
- It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and /or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and /or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Trial Committee, be asked to leave the trial site. In such case, no refund on any fees paid will be made.
- All dogs must be on leash at all times except when in the ring or when in the designated agility warm-up area.
- Exhibitors are responsible for being at the ring gate when it is their turn to run.
- Please be courteous and pick up after your dog.
- Exhibitors, while competing must wear proper footwear. Exhibitors will not be allowed to compete in "bare" feet or open toe shoes.
- No smoking in buildings or arena.
- Dogs under six months of age are prohibited at AKC Agility Trials
- Exhibitors should follow their veterinarian's recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.

INSTRUCTIONS

Handlers may opt to enter in a higher height division for all *Regular* titling classes and the *FAST* titling classes, but not in a division lower than their proper height division.

Dogs entered in the *Preferred* classes must compete at the required jump height and may not compete in a jump height higher or lower than their proper height division.

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an Agility Jump Height Card may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. The Judge's measurement will be valid for this trial or *back-to-back trials* only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.
