Preliminary running

order contingent on move-up entries not yet received. Exhibitors shall be provided armbands or stickers indicating their dog's running order number for this trial. Per AKC rules, the move up deadline is 6 pm on Monday, February 26, 2009. Absolutely no move ups for Saturday will be allowed after this time and date. Move ups for Sunday must be given to the Trial Secretary, at the show site, in writing within 15 minutes of the last dog completing the course of Saturday.

Novice B/A Standard, JWW and FAST classes will run together by jump heights with division B running before division A. Excellent B/A Standard, JWW and FAST classes will run together by jump heights with division B running before division A. The preferred classes will

run intermingled with the regular classes by height. Each class will be briefed separately. Lunch breaks will be at the Judge's discretion. A warm-up area, consisting of a regulation agility jump will be provided for all exhibitors.

Set Ups No exhibitor set ups before 3 pm on Friday unless you are part of the set up crew.

RV Parking You will receive a parking pass in the U.S. mail the week before the show. We never know in advance if the fairgrounds will allow RV parking on the grass. When you arrive follow the example of the other RVs.

Food and beverages

Dannie's Catering will be onsite Saturday and Sunday.

Check in will begin at 7:00 am on Saturday and Sunday. Armbands may be picked up at the score table each morning.

Judging will begin on

Saturday and Sunday at 8:00 am.

Walk through will begin as soon as the Judge has approved the course. This will be at approximately 7:30 am. Open and Novice, all heights will walk the course together prior to their class being judged. Excellent Standard and JWW will be split into four groups as follows:

Group 1: 20

Group 2: 4/8/24/26

Group 3: 12

Group 4: 16

Excellent FAST: all heights will walk together.

The order will be walk run, walk run, etc.

Preferred will run BEFORE the regular at each height.

Unless you have a conflict, i.e. showing in another ring or working, you MUST walk with your group.

No set ups or marking off space around the rings before 3 pm.

Directions:

From I-80 west in Dixon, take 113 South towards Dixon.

From I-80 east, take the Dixon Ave/A Street exit and go right on A Street. Turn right on First Street. The fairgrounds are 3 blocks south on your left side. Go past the office/main entrance drive and turn left into the south end of the fairgrounds.

Both rings will be on the South Lawn.

All About the Height Cards

All dogs, regardless of jump height, must either: present a height card at check, send a copy of their height card with entry to this show, or be measured. Dogs that do not have an AKC height card or who

have not provided a copy of their height card to the trial secretary must be measured BEFORE their first run of the weekend.

Measurement of dogs without height cards will take place near the score

table at the top of each hour for approximately 10 minutes unless Tammy Domico is running her dogs or course building.

Saturday: 285 dogs and 660 runs

Laura Finco will judge all Standard Classes, Novice FAST, Open JWW.

Terry Culley will judge Excellent & Novice JWW, Excellent & Open FAST.

Sunday: 283 dogs and 660 runs

Laura Finco will judge all JWW Classes except for Ex A & Ex preferred, Open FAST, Excellent FAST.

Terry Culley will judge all Standard Classes, Novice FAST, Ex A JWW, Excellent preferred JWW.

Directions: Take I-80 towards Sacramento. Take 113 north towards Woodland. Take the first exit (Hutchison Drive) and bear right (east) on Hutchison Drive. Turn right at the first stop light (LaRue Road). Follow LaRue Road to the first right turn (Garrod Drive). Follow Garrod Drive to the stop sign. After stopping, proceed directly ahead. The client parking lot entrance is on your right. Client parking is free as long as you park in a designated patient parking space. Client parking cannot accommodate vehicles that require more space than a passenger car. There are three different reception stations and it is important to come to the station mentioned when you made your appointment. Reception station 3 is in the building on your left as you drive toward the parking lot and reception stations 1 and 2 are in the main hospital building which is to the west of the parking lot. Drive time approximately 15 minutes.

Standard Ring

Open, Excellent, Novice then Novice FAST

JWW Ring

Excellent FAST, Open FAST then **JWW Excellent A & all preferred heights, Excellent B, Open, Novice

Height Order

Saturday—Excellent Std and Excellent JWW
26, 24, 4, 8, 20, 12, 16

All other classes will run small to tall

Sunday—Excellent Std and Excellent JWW
16, 12, 4, 8, 24, 26, 20

All other classes will run tall to small

****While the Standard judge is on assignment in the JWW ring, all Excellent Standard handlers who have not already done so MUST walk the Standard Course. Once judging resumes there not be any further Excellent Standard walk throughs.**

The 411 on Conflicts

We understand there may be legitimate ring conflicts. Every effort will be made to accommodate conflicts, however, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to check in, mark their dogs as a conflict if necessary and walk courses when assigned. We can reset bars for exhibitors "caught" in other rings BUT we cannot hold any course waiting for conflicts.

It's Really a Conflict, So How Do I Move My Dog?

Exhibitors may NOT move their own dogs at the gate. Moves at the gate can only be made one of the following persons: Any Judge of record for this weekend's event

Gate Steward assigned to that class.

If you have a legitimate conflict or less than 5 dogs separate two or more dogs run by the same handler in the same class, speak with one of these people and they will move your dog.

Potty Areas

Do not allow your dog to potty on ANY manmade object. This includes trashcans, ring stakes, canopy legs, table legs, gate boards, planters, benches, chairs or any other manmade object.

Your dog may relieve himself on trees, grass, dirt and the like. Failure to follow these directions may result in a bench committee hearing. Remember to pick up after you dog.

You Make The Call



Incident: When checking the posted scores you discover your dog is marked NQ. You believe the score should be a Q because you KNOW the run was clean and your friend who watched the run swears the judge never raised their hand(s).

Which is the most appropriate response?

A. Complain to everyone who will listen that your posted score is wrong while vowing NEVER to enter an AKC show again. After all, this would never happen at USDAA, CPE, NADAC.

B. Accuse the score table of intentionally marking your dog NQ because they are out to get you.

C. Corner the judge before they have reviewed the scribe sheets and ask if they remember your run and why it is an NQ.

D. Immediately call an AKC Representative on your cell phone to complain.

E. Ask the score table if you can see the scribe sheet to find out if this is an honest error made by the score table/scribe or if in fact a W in JWW really does mean NQ.

Each of these choices have occurred but only one is the most appropriate and should be the first choice of action. Answer will be posted at the check in table at the show.

Campers



Those on the set up list may begin arriving at 10:00 am on Friday. All others may begin arriving at 3:00 pm.

Daily Parking

Vehicles may drive in to unload and load each day. All vehicles MUST be moved to the regular parking lot by 7:30 AM. Vehicles may enter to load AFTER judging is finished for the day. This rule is for the safety of the dogs and exhibitors.

The regular parking lot is behind the red fence which runs parallel to the South Lawn. Additional parking is across the street from the fairgrounds.

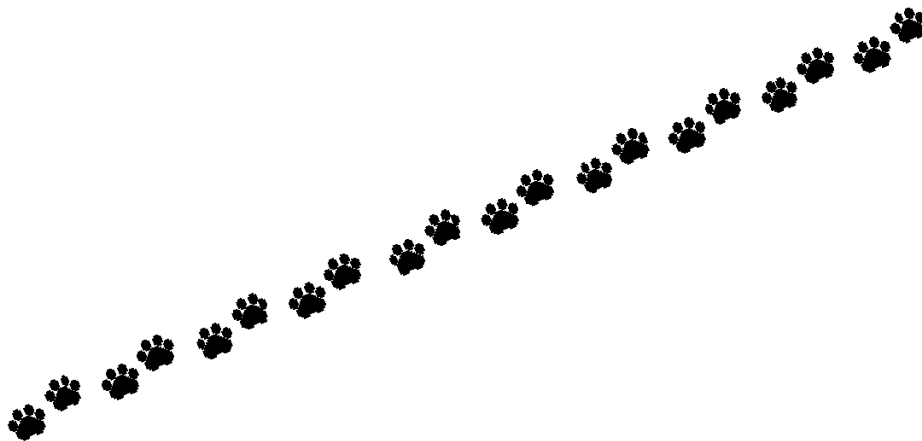
