Preliminary running

order contingent on move-up entries not yet received. Exhibitors shall be provided armbands or stickers indicating their dog's running order number for this trial. Per AKC rules, the move up deadline is 6 pm on Monday, May 4, 2009.

Absolutely no move ups for Friday will be allowed after this time and date. Move ups for Saturday must be given to the Trial Secretary, at the show site, in writing within 15 minutes of the last dog completing the course of Saturday. Move ups for Sunday must be given to the Trial Secretary, at the show site, in writing within 15 minutes of the last dog completing the course on Saturday.

Novice B/A Standard, JWW and FAST classes will run together by jump heights with division B running before division A. Excellent B/A Standard,

JWW and FAST classes will run together by jump heights with division B running before division A. The preferred classes will run intermingled with the regular classes by height. Each class will be briefed separately. Lunch breaks will be at the Judge's discretion. A warm-up area, consisting of a regulation agility jump will be provided for all exhibitors.

Set Ups No exhibitor set ups before 11 am on Friday unless you are part of the set up crew.

Food and beverages

There is a fruit deli and restaurant at the show site.

Check in will begin at noon on Friday and 7:00 am on Saturday and Sunday. Armbands may be picked up at the score table each day.

Judging will begin on Friday at 1:00 pm and on Saturday and Sunday at 8:00 am.

Walk through will begin as soon as the Judge has approved the course. This will be at approximately 12:30 pm on Friday and 7:30 am on Saturday and Sunday. Open and Novice, all heights will walk the course together prior to their class being judged. Excellent Standard and JWW will be split into two groups as follows:

Group 1: 20

Group 2: 4/8/24/26

Group 3: 12

Group 4: 16

Excellent FAST: all heights will walk together.

The order will be walk run, walk run, etc.

Unless you have a conflict, i.e. showing in another ring or working, you **MUST** walk with your group.

No set ups or marking off space around the rings before 11 am on Friday.

Directions:

Casa de Fruta is located 2 miles east of the junction of Highway 152 and Highway 156.

From highway 5 take 152 West and travel approximately 28 miles.

From San Jose take 101 south to 152 east.

From Monterey take 101 north to 156 north/east to 152 east.

Follow the freeway signs to Casa de Fruta. Follow Frontage Rd past Casa de Diesel towards the RV park.

Parking is available through gate 6 .

All About the Height Cards

All dogs, regardless of jump height, must either: present a height card at check, send a copy of their height card with entry to this show, or be measured. Dogs that do not have an AKC height card or who

have not provided a copy of their height card to the trial secretary must be measured **BEFORE** their first run of the weekend.

Ann McQuillen will measure dogs for height cards 12:30 pm on Friday,

7:30 am on Saturday and Sunday and between classes when she is not judging or otherwise occupied.

Start traveling Northwest on Airline Hwy / CA-25 toward Quien Sabe Rd and travel approximately 5 miles.

Turn right onto Fairview Rd and travel approximately 3.6 miles. Turn left onto McCloskey Rd and travel approximately 2 miles. McCloskey will become Wright Rd continue another .3 miles. Turn right onto Bolsa Rd/CA25 and follow for 10.5 miles. Merge onto US-101 north toward Gilroy approximately 7 miles. Take the Masten Ave exit . Turn left onto Masten Ave and travel approximately 1 mile. . Turn right onto Monterey Rd. Clinic will be approximately 2 miles. Total distance 31.25 miles. Estimated travel time 38 minutes.

Dogs will be judged from the lowest armband number in each class to the highest armband number in each class.

The 411 on Conflicts

We understand there may be legitimate ring conflicts. Every effort will be made to accommodate conflicts, however, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to check in, mark their dogs as a conflict if necessary and walk courses when assigned. We can reset bars for exhibitors "caught" in other rings BUT we cannot hold any course waiting for conflicts.

It's Really a Conflict, So How Do I Move My Dog?

Exhibitors may NOT move their own dogs at the gate. Moves at the gate can only be made one of the following persons:

If you have a legitimate conflict or less than 5 dogs separate two or more dogs run by the same handler in the same class, speak with one of these people and they will move your dog.

Potty Areas

Do not allow your dog to potty on ANY manmade object. This includes trashcans, ring stakes, canopy legs, table legs, gate boards, planters, benches, chairs or any other manmade object.

Your dog may relieve himself on trees, grass, dirt and the like. Failure to follow these directions may result in a bench committee hearing. Remember to pick up after you dog.
