Set Ups, Check In, Start Times, Walk Through

Preliminary running

order contingent on move-up entries not yet received. Exhibitors shall be provided armbands or stickers indicating their dog's running order number for this trial. Per AKC rules, the move up deadline is 6 pm on Monday, March 8, 2009. Absolutely no move ups for Saturday will be allowed after this time and date. Move ups for Sunday must be given to the Trial Secretary, at the show site, in writing within 15 minutes of the last dog completing the course of Saturday.

Novice B/A Standard, JWW and FAST classes will run together by jump heights with division B running before division A. Excellent B/A Standard, JWW and FAST classes will run together by jump heights with division B running before division A. The preferred classes will run intermingled with the

regular classes by height. Each class will be briefed separately. Lunch breaks will be at the Judge's discretion. A warm-up area, consisting of a regulation agility jump will be provided for all exhibitors.

Set Ups No exhibitor set ups before 3 pm on Friday unless you are part of the set up crew.

RV Parking You will receive a parking pass in the U.S. mail the week before the show. We never know in advance if the fairgrounds will allow RV parking on the grass. When you arrive follow the example of the other RVs.

Food and beverages

Dannie's Catering will be onsite Saturday and Sunday.

Check in will begin at 7:30 am on Saturday and Sunday. Armbands may be picked up at the score table each morning.

Judging will begin on

Saturday and Sunday at 8:30 am.

Walk through will begin as soon as the Judge has approved the course. This will be at approximately 8:00 am. Open and Novice, all heights will walk the course together prior to their class being judged. Excellent Standard and JWW will be split into four groups as follows:

Group 1: 20

Group 2: 4/8/24/26

Group 3: 12

Group 4: 16

Excellent FAST: all heights will walk together.

The order will be walk run, walk run, etc.

Preferred will run BEFORE the regular at each height.

Unless you have a conflict, i.e. showing in another ring or working, you **MUST** walk with your group.

No set ups or marking off space around the rings before 3 pm.

Directions:

From I-80 west in Dixon, take 113 South towards Dixon.

From I-80 east, take the Dixon Ave/A Street exit and go right on A Street. Turn right on First Street. The fairgrounds are 3 blocks south on your left side. Go past the office/main entrance drive and turn left into the south end of the fairgrounds.

Both rings will be on the South Lawn.

All About the Height Cards

All dogs, regardless of jump height, must either: present a height card at check, send a copy of their height card with entry to this show, or be measured. Dogs that do not have an AKC height card or who

have not provided a copy of their height card to the trial secretary must be measured BEFORE their first run of the weekend.

Measurement of dogs without height cards will take place near the score

table at the top of each hour for approximately 10 minutes unless Cindy Macklin is otherwise course walking or running her dog.

Directions: Take I-80 towards Sacramento. Take 113 north towards Woodland. Take the first exit (Hutchison Drive) and bear right (east) on Hutchison Drive. Turn right at the first stop light (LaRue Road). Follow LaRue Road to the first right turn (Garrod Drive). Follow Garrod Drive to the stop sign. After stopping, proceed directly ahead. The client parking lot entrance is on your right. Client parking is free as long as you park in a designated patient parking space. Client parking cannot accommodate vehicles that require more space than a passenger car. There are three different reception stations and it is important to come to the station mentioned when you made your appointment. Reception station 3 is in the building on your left as you drive toward the parking lot and reception stations 1 and 2 are in the main hospital building which is to the west of the parking lot. Drive time approximately 15 minutes.

The 411 on Conflicts

We understand there may be legitimate ring conflicts. Every effort will be made to accommodate conflicts, however, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to check in, mark their dogs as a conflict if necessary and walk courses when assigned. We can reset bars for exhibitors "caught" in other rings BUT we cannot hold any course waiting for conflicts.

It's Really a Conflict, So How Do I Move My Dog?

Exhibitors may NOT move their own dogs at the gate. Moves at the gate can only be made one of the following persons:

If you have a legitimate conflict or less than 5 dogs separate two or more dogs run by the same handler in the same class, speak with one of these people and they will move your dog.

Potty Areas

Do not allow your dog to potty on ANY manmade object. This includes trashcans, ring stakes, canopy legs, table legs, gate boards, planters, benches, chairs or any other manmade object.

Your dog may relieve himself on trees, grass, dirt and the like. Failure to follow these directions may result in a bench committee hearing. Remember to pick up after you dog.

You Make The Call

Incident: During the week preceding each and every show multiple requests for refund of entry fees arrive by email and phone.

Quoting from The American Kennel Club Rules Applying to Dog Shows, Chapter 11, Section 6: No entry may be changed or canceled unless notice of the change or cancellation is received in writing or by telegram by the Superintendent or Show Secretary named in the premium list to receive entries, *prior to the closing date and hour for entries*. Reading from the Regulations for Agility Trials, Chapter 1, Section 19 the exception to the above rule allows that move ups may be accepted until 6 pm on the Monday preceding the set of trials for trials starting on a Thursday—Sunday.



Considering these rules, under which condition would an exhibitor be entitled to a refund of entry fees *after* the closing date and time?


Each of the following reasons have been given at one time or another but only one is allowed by AKC. Can you name the *only* reason the AKC rules will allow a

refund of entry fees?

- A. Due to the numerous brush fires burning this summer my doctor has advised that I stay indoors. Can I have a refund?
- B. It was 106 at the show site last weekend. I wasn't there, but I'm sure the show was cancelled. When will my refund check arrive?
- C. It's scheduled to rain this weekend (email received the Wednesday before the show) will the event be cancelled? Will we receive refunds?
- D. I've taken ill, twisted my ankle, broke my finger nail, my brother is sick—you fill in the blank— so I need to withdraw from the show and am requesting a full refund.
- E. My dog competed on Saturday and was injured. Can I have a refund for Sunday?
- F. My intact bitch has come into season. I understand a full refund is not possible but can I receive a partial refund?
- G. I know it's my error but I entered the same show, with the same dog twice! Can one of the entries be refunded?
- H. The show was cancelled part way through the day and I didn't get my second run. Will I receive a refund?

Answer will be posted at the check in table at the show.

Campers




Those on the set up list may begin arriving at 10:00 am on Friday. All others may begin arriving at 3:00 pm.

Daily Parking

Vehicles may drive in to unload and load each day. All vehicles **MUST** be moved to the regular parking lot by 7:30 AM. Vehicles may enter to load **AFTER** judging is finished for the day. This rule is for the safety of the dogs and exhibitors.

The regular parking lot is next to the building on the South end of the fairgrounds. Additional parking is across the street from the fairgrounds.

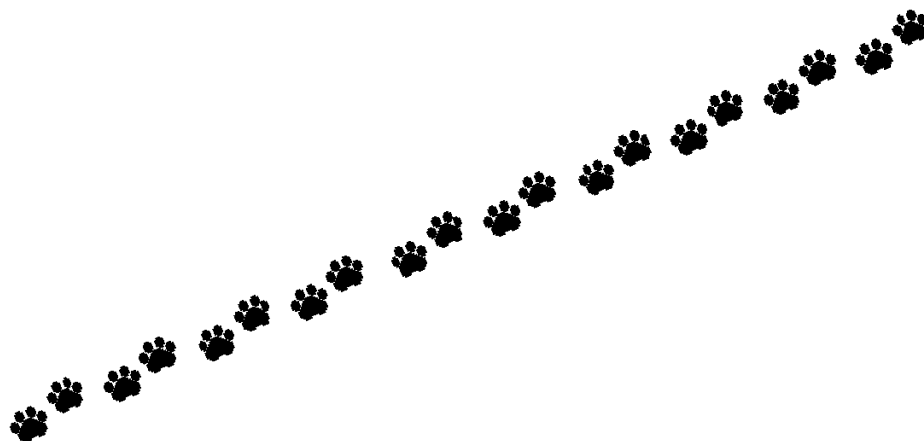
