BEST UNLOADING ~ Enter the grounds through Gate 12 off Valley Avenue. After paying proceed straight ahead, down Roadway 12, heading east into the sun. At the end make a right and drive through the Tunnel and off load along the roadway by the North Forty rings. When you've finished unloading please park your vehicle in the parking lots on the other side of the tunnel, along Roadway 12. This unloading loop will be in place 6 a.m. to 6 p.m. all four days.

IMPORTANT NOTICE TO ALL EXHIBITORS
Cleaning up after your dog is your responsibility!

Pooper-scoopers (in chlorine filled buckets) will be placed all around the show grounds and outside all show rings. If your dog soils the parking lot, show grounds or the rings, it is your responsibility to clean it up. By signing the entry form for this show, you are agreeing that clean-up is your responsibility. Violators may be subject to an Event Committee Hearing. Thank you for your cooperation.

EXHIBITORS and HANDLERS will be held responsible for clean conditions in and around their crates.

We kindly request of all exhibitors and visitors please do not leave dogs in inadequately ventilated cars or crates. If any dog is found to appear to be in distress where it is confined without supervision, Animal Control and Law Enforcement personnel will be called to deal with the situation. If it is necessary to rescue a dog from a parked car on the show grounds, the club will not be responsible or liable for any damage to the car involved. Please DO NOT leave your dogs unattended while on the show grounds.

ALL DOGS PRESENT MUST BE HELD ON LEASH OR CONFINED TO THEIR CRATES EXCEPT WHEN BEING JUDGED. THERE ARE NO EXERCISE OR PRACTICE RINGS AT THE SHOW SITE. THERE IS NO PRACTICING ALLOWED IN THE RINGS AT ANYTIME. DO NOT 'EXERCISE' YOUR DOG IN ANY RING ON THE SHOW SITE. VIOLATORS MAY BE SUBJECT TO AN EVENT COMMITTEE HEARING.

SHOW LIMITS: The Jockeys, trainers and horse owners have asked that no exhibitors or dog be allowed by horse stables, race track or horse exercise areas. If frightens their animals. Please abide by their wishes.

Only dogs that are eligible to be shown under the American Kennel Club Rules shall be allowed within the show precincts.

DOG WASHING ON THE FAIRGROUNDS: The 1996 Clean Water Act is now being enforced at the Alameda County Fairgrounds. All gray water which includes soapy water from washing dogs) must be discharged into sanitary sewer systems only, and not dumped onto the ground or into storm drains. A hefty fine can be leveled against offenders. Del Valle will be placing Dog Bathtubs around the grounds for your convenience. Please check the Fairgrounds map in the Judging Program for designated dog washing locations. We will do our best to make it easy for all of you.

Ramps may be used in emergency situations to judge any breed. (In an emergency situation, an exhibitor does have the option of withdrawing their entry and receiving a refund.)

Prizes—Trophies, Ribbons, Certificates and other prizes will be awarded in the ring to the person exhibiting the dog, who shall be considered the owner or agent. Please advise the Superintendent of any discrepancy at once. The club reserves the right to substitute unavailable prize with one of equal or greater value. Prizes will not be mailed.

Dogs may arrive anytime before judging begins. Judging will begin promptly at 11:00 AM. in ring 43 and at 11:00 AM in ring 43A. Dogs not required for further judging will be excused. Judges are not required to wait for dogs. They will adhere as closely as possible to the judging schedule printed in this program. For convenience, the class divisions shown have been carefully tabulated; however, neither the Club nor the Show Secretary assume responsibility for complete accuracy.
