Preliminary running

order contingent on move-up entries not yet received. Exhibitors shall be provided armbands or stickers indicating their dog's running order number for this trial. Per AKC rules, the move up deadline is 6 pm on Monday, March 2, 2009. Absolutely no move ups for Saturday will be allowed after this time and date. Move ups for Sunday must be given to the Trial Secretary, at the show site, in writing within 15 minutes of the last dog completing the course of Saturday.

Novice B/A Standard, JWW and FAST classes will run together by jump heights with division B running before division A. Excellent B/A Standard, JWW and FAST classes will run together by jump heights with division B running before division A. The preferred classes will run intermingled with the

regular classes by height. Each class will be briefed separately. Lunch breaks will be at the Judge's discretion. A warm-up area, consisting of a regulation agility jump will be provided for all exhibitors.

Check in will begin at 7:00 am on Saturday and at 8:00 am Sunday. Armbands may be picked up at the score table each day.

Judging will begin at 8:00 am on Saturday and at 9:00 am on Sunday.

Walk through will begin as soon as the Judge has approved the course. This will be at approximately 7:30 am on Saturday and at 8:30 am on Sunday. Novice, Open and Excellent, all heights will walk the course together prior to their class being judged.

RV Parking—RVs may begin arriving after 3 pm

on Friday. Overnight vehicles may park in the center of the racetrack near the scoreboard. Please park close to one another and conserve space. We need to fit 7 RVs in this area. No power or water will be available. Enter through gate 7 only which is located on Butler Ave.

Parking is available in the center of the racetrack free of charge. You MUST enter through gate 7 off Butler Ave.

Food and beverages

The Fairgrounds food vendor will be open selling lunch items each day. .

Exhibitors may begin setting up crating areas at 11:00 am on Friday.

Directions:

From the 99-freeway North or Southbound, take the Ventura St. exit and turn East. Travel approximately three miles and turn right onto Chance. The fairgrounds will be immediately on your left. The fairgrounds property is bordered by four streets; Chance Ave, Maple Ave, Kings Canyon Ave and Butler Ave. Enter through gate 7 which is on the Butler Ave side of the fairgrounds.



All About the Height Cards

All dogs, regardless of jump height must either: present a height card at check, send a copy of their height card with entry to this show, or be measured. Dogs that do not have an AKC height card or who

have not provided a copy of their height card to the trial secretary must be measured BEFORE their first run of the weekend.

Measurement of dogs without height cards will take place near the score

table at approximately 7:30 on Saturday and 8:30 am on Sunday. Sharon Kihara will measure dogs for height cards.

Class Order, Height Order, Which Judge when

Saturday: 103 dogs and 254 runs

Sharon Kihara will judge all classes including FAST

Sunday: 97 dogs and 161 runs

Sharon Kihara Kylie Bourke will judge all Standard and JWW classes. FAST not offered

Judging will begin each day in the Standard ring. Judging will rotate between JWW and Standard. Exhibitors are expected to walk the course in the “down” ring while judging takes place in the “active” ring. Lunch break will be at the judge’s discretion.

Dogs will be judged from the lowest armband number in each class to the highest armband number in each class.

Class Order

Standard Ring—each day

Excellent, Open, Novice Standard. On Saturday the FAST classes will follow the Standard classes. FAST class order will be Excellent, Open, Novice.

JWW Ring—each day

Excellent, Open, Novice

Height Order

Saturday—16, 20, 4, 8, 24, 26, 12

FAST will run Small to Tall

Sunday—Small to Tall, all classes

Preferred heights will run after the regular heights.

Daylight Savings Time

Daylight Savings Time will begin at 2:00 am on Sunday morning. Don’t forget to “Spring Forward” and set your clock forward one hour before bed Saturday night.

Judging will begin at 8:00 am on Saturday.
