Follow LaRue Road to the first right turn (Garrod Drive). Follow Garrod Drive to the stop sign. After stopping, proceed directly ahead. The Client parking lot entrance is on your right. Client parking is free as long as you park in a designated 'Patient Parking' space. There are three different reception stations and it is important to come to the station mentioned when you made your appointment or as directed in your reminder letter. ADDITIONAL TRIAL / TEST REGULATIONS

- Telegraph, telephone, FAX and unsigned entries cannot be accepted. Entries not on official AKC entry forms and photocopies of entry forms without the agreement and rules on the reverse side of the official AKC entry forms are not acceptable.
