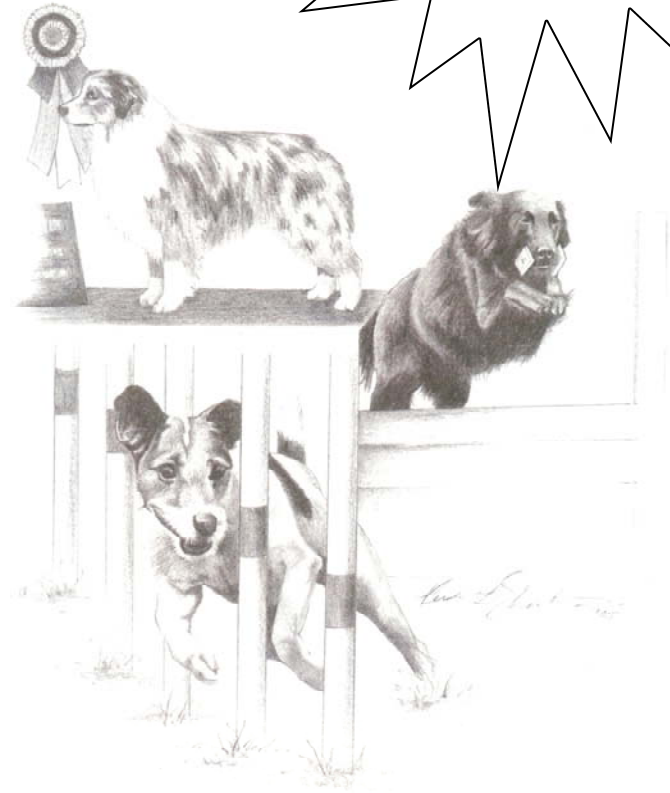

NEW! NEW! NEW! **2010 RV Overnight Parking**

On October 13, 2009 the San Francisco Bay Area was deluged by the largest wind and rain storm in 50 years. RV's began rolling onto the Alameda County Fairgrounds on October 15. The grounds were soaked and the Fairgrounds asked us not to use most of the grass areas we usually used for parking. We lost 98 parking spaces. Some of you ended up parking a very long way away from where you wanted to be. We sincerely apologize to you for this inconvenience but it was Mother Nature in charge, not us. With a little luck we'll have back all our normal parking spaces.

2010 HARVEST MOON CLASSIC RV PARKING FORM

We ask all exhibitors to be patient with us as we are dealing with new Fairgrounds' on-site rules. We are the only event still permitted to park on the grounds so we are doing our best to make this work for all involved. **All RV parking** is through Gate 12 off Valley Avenue. Make the first right after passing the Watch & Wager Building and follow the signs. Do not proceed to your RV parking space without an escort. \$45 per night for a 20' x 40' space. If your vehicle is larger you must buy two spaces. Reserved Box Van day parking \$35. Unreserved RV overnight parking in large paved parking lot is \$50 per night. Electrical hook-ups not guaranteed. If available in your area you will be charged, \$10 additional per night for 30 amp service, \$15 additional per night for 50 amp service. Del Valle does not make a profit on RV parking, we are simply passing along to you what we are charged. Trailers and tow units may be required to be unhitched. Tagalong vehicles will be parked in a special area. **All vehicles** must have a working fire extinguisher, be self-contained, no discharge of gray water permitted. No electrical cords permitted across paths or roadways. Persons who break open locked boxes or otherwise damage property in order to find electricity will be held responsible for damage and may be asked to leave. No running of generators after 11 p.m. or before 5 a.m. Those wishing to park together must send reservations in together, however there is no guarantee that we can accommodate all requests. **All parking** is at your own risk. Neither the Alameda Co. Fair Assn. or Harvest Moon Classic assumes any responsibility for fire, theft, and/or loss of vehicles or their contents. The Cluster reserves the right to withdraw parking privileges, without return of parking or entry fees, for anyone who cannot abide by these rules or who resorts to abusive language or actions. Violators may be subject to Event Committee charges.

Reserved RV overnight parking hours: Wednesday 2 pm to 11 pm, all other days 6 am to 11 pm. If your assigned spot is on the show grounds you will have to wait until judging in that area concludes as no moving vehicles permitted past active rings.

Trial Site and Accommodations

Gate 12 Grass Area – Alameda County Fairgrounds, Pleasanton.

The site is outdoors on grass. The rings will measure 100' x 100'. Food and beverages will be available for purchase on the show grounds from a variety of vendors. All vendors will be located approximately 10 walking minutes from the agility rings.

Directions:

From the 680 North or Southbound – in the Pleasanton area take the Bernal Ave. exit. Go east on Bernal and turn left onto Valley Ave. Enter through gate 12. Rings will be on your left.

Motels that accept dogs

UNLOADING INFORMATION

Unloading is through BOTH the Main Gate off Pleasanton Avenue and Gate 12 off Valley Avenue. Any exhibitor may drive onto the grounds to unload between 6 a.m. and 7:15 a.m. Please leave your headlights on while on the grounds. All vehicles must be off the grounds by 7:30 a.m. or they will be towed. Be sure to allow yourself plenty of time as for obvious safety reasons this cannot be extended. Except for medical emergencies no vehicles may drive onto the show grounds after 7:15 a.m. You may drive back onto the grounds to load up only after all judging in your area has concluded. After 7:15 a.m. an unloading loop will be open all day between the Young California and Exhibition Buildings (accessed through the main paved parking lot) and through the tunnel in the back for the North Forty rings.

Notice to Exhibitors

- This event is open to all AKC registered dogs 15 months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have obtained AKC ILP/PAL numbers or are listed in the AKC Canine Partners Program, except bitches in season, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance. Refer to Chapter 2 of the Registration and Discipline rules for the listing of registrable breeds that may participate.
- Running order will be determined by random draw. Handlers with more than one dog in a class will have those dogs separated as much as possible.
- If a dog and/or handler are dismissed, regardless of the reason, there will be NO refund of entry fees.
- 50% refund for bitches in season after the closing date and up to the Friday before the event.
- Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused or barred from competition by action of the Trial Committee.
- No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.
- EXHIBITORS ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR COMPLETE, ACCURATE, AND LEGIBLE INFORMATION ON THEIR ENTRY FORMS; ILLEGIBLE OR INCOMPLETE ENTRIES CANNOT BE ENTERED IN THE TRIAL.
- It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and /or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and /or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Trial Committee, be asked to leave the trial site. In such case, no refund on any fees paid will be made.
- All dogs must be on leash at all times except when in the ring or when in the designated agility warm-up area.
- Exhibitors are responsible for being at the ring gate when it is their turn to run.
- Please be courteous and pick up after your dog.
- Exhibitors, while competing must wear proper footwear. Exhibitors will not be allowed to compete in "bare" feet or open toe shoes.
- No smoking in buildings or arena.
- Dogs under six months of age are prohibited at AKC Agility Trials.
- Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendations to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations. Rabies vaccine is required in the State of California.
- Failure to follow the instructions of the Show Committee or their Agent will result in a Bench Committee Hearing
- Unsportsmanlike conduct will result in a Bench Committee Hearing

Unless otherwise noted, the Agility High in Trial award is determined by actual time vs. standard course time on the Regular Standard or JWW course. Only perfect scores of 100 will be considered. If more than one dog has the same time, the award will first be given to the dog with the greatest number of FAST points.

Class Information and Obstacles

Classes offered: Regular Titling: Novice A & B, Open, Excellent A & B for Standard, JWW and FAST. Preferred: Novice, Open, Excellent A & B for Standard, JWW and FAST. Owners are responsible for entering the proper class. Complete rules can be found on the AKC website at www.akc.org. For a copy of the rule book write to: American Kennel Club, 8051 Arco Corporate Dr., Ste. 100, Raleigh, NC 27617-2028. To place a credit card order by telephone call: 919-233-9767 voice and 919-816-3627 fax. Minimum order is \$10. Obstacles will conform to the current edition of the AKC Regulations for Agility Trials.

Awards

Flat ribbons will be awarded 1st—4th place in each jump height class to dogs earning a qualifying score. Green ribbons will be awarded to all dogs earning a qualifying score. Rosettes will be awarded to dogs finishing a title. Rosettes will be awarded to Ex B Std/JWW dogs earning a Double Q. QQQ pins will be awarded to Ex B Std/JWW/FAST dogs earning a triple Q. MACH Rosette will be awarded to all dogs earning the MACH title.

Move-Up Regulations

Dogs may be moved up to a higher class at the request of the owner, as a result of qualifying for an agility title, provided that the request is received in writing by the Trial Secretary, no later than 6 pm on the Monday preceding the event. Sunday move ups will be allowed provided that the request is received in writing by the Trial Secretary, at the show site, no later than 15 minutes after the last dog has crossed the finish line on Saturday.

Course Familiarization/Warm-ups

Handlers in all classes are permitted to walk the course, without a dog, prior to the start of a class. The walk through is restricted to handlers entered in that class. A warm-up jump will be provided for each ring.

Handlers may opt to enter in a higher **height division** for all **Regular** titling classes, but not in a division lower than their proper height division. Dogs entered in the **Preferred** classes **must** compete at the required jump height and **may not** compete in a jump height division **higher or lower** than their proper height divisions.

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an **Agility Jump Height Card** may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. If measured by the Judge of record, that measurement will be valid for this trial or **back-to-back trials** only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.

Dogs enrolled in the AKC Canine Partners program may be eligible to enter all-breed AKC agility trials at the club's option effective April 1, 2010. These dogs should be listed as All American Dog and must include their AKC number n the entry form and check the AKC No. bos.

Junior Handlers should enter their Junior Handler number on the front of this form. Should you not have your Junior Handler number, it may be obtained from the American Kennel Club (919) 816-3776. If the Junior Handler is not the owner of the dog identified on the face of this form, what relationship is the Junior Handler to the Owner? _____
