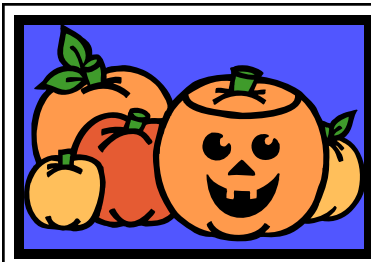

2010 RV Overnight Parking**

On October 13, 2009 the San Francisco Bay Area was deluged by the largest wind and rain storm in 50 years. RV's began rolling onto the Alameda County Fairgrounds on October 15. The grounds were soaked and the Fairgrounds asked us not to use most of the grass areas we usually used for parking. We lost 98 parking spaces. Some of you ended up parking a very long way away from where you wanted to be. We sincerely apologize to you for this inconvenience but it was Mother Nature in charge, not us. With a little luck we'll have back all our normal parking spaces.

2010 HARVEST MOON CLASSIC RV PARKING FORM

We ask all exhibitors to be patient with us as we are dealing with new Fairgrounds' on-site rules. We are the only event still permitted to park on the grounds so we are doing our best to make this work for all involved. **All RV parking** is through Gate 12 off Valley Avenue. Make the first right after passing the Watch & Wager Building and follow the signs. Do not proceed to your RV parking space without an escort. \$45 per night for a 20' x 40' space. If your vehicle is larger you must buy two spaces. Reserved Box Van day parking \$35. Unreserved RV overnight parking in large paved parking lot is \$50 per night. Electrical hook-ups not guaranteed. If available in your area you will be charged, \$10 additional per night for 30 amp service, \$15 additional per night for 50 amp service. Del Valle does not make a profit on RV parking, we are simply passing along to you what we are charged. Trailers and tow units may be required to be unhitched. Tagalong vehicles will be parked in a special area. **All vehicles** must have a working fire extinguisher, be self-contained, no discharge of gray water permitted. No electrical cords permitted across paths or roadways. Persons who break open locked boxes or otherwise damage property in order to find electricity will be held responsible for damage and may be asked to leave. No running of generators after 11 p.m. or before 5 a.m. Those wishing to park together must send reservations in together, however there is no guarantee that we can accommodate all requests. **All parking** is at your own risk. Neither the Alameda Co. Fair Assn. or Harvest Moon Classic assumes any responsibility for fire, theft, and/or loss of vehicles or their contents. The Cluster reserves the right to withdraw parking privileges, without return of parking or entry fees, for anyone who cannot abide by these rules or who resorts to abusive language or actions. Violators may be subject to Event Committee charges.

Reserved RV overnight parking hours: Wednesday 2 pm to 11 pm, all other days 6 am to 11 pm. If your assigned spot is on the show grounds you will have to wait until judging in that area concludes as no moving vehicles permitted past active rings.

Cleaning up after your dog is your responsibility!

Pooper-scoopers (in chlorine filled buckets) will be placed all around the show grounds and outside all show rings. If your dog soils the parking lot, show grounds or the rings, it is your responsibility to clean it up. By signing the entry form for this show, you are agreeing that clean-up is your responsibility. Violators may be subject to an Event Committee Hearing.

GROOMING AND SET-UPS NO X-PENS PERMITTED IN ANY BUILDING

Dogs and Equipment may be left in these buildings overnight. But you do so entirely at your own risk. Please mark the top of each crate with the phone number where you may be reached should any problems arise in your absence.

All buildings will be locked from 10:00 p.m. to 6:00 a.m. each evening. Neither the Officers & Directors, Employees & Members of the Alameda County Fairgrounds, superintendent or the Club assume any responsibility for lost, stolen or damaged property or dogs. Please stack crates and conserve space in consideration of others. A Roving Security Guard will be roaming the grounds overnight.

The Grooming Building is located just West of the Hall of Commerce and will open Friday morning at 6:00 a.m. and be available through the weekend.

DOG WASHING ON THE FAIRGROUNDS: The 1996 Clean Water Act is now being enforced at the Alameda County Fairgrounds. All gray water which includes soapy water from washing dogs) must be discharged into sanitary sewer systems only, and not dumped onto the ground or into storm drains. A hefty fine can be leveled against offenders. Del Valle will be placing Dog Bathtubs around the grounds for your convenience. Please look for designated dog washing locations.

SHOW LIMITS

The Jockeys, trainers and horse owners have asked that no exhibitors or dogs be allowed by horse stables, race track or horse exercise areas. It frightens their animals. Please abide by their wishes.

GENERAL INFORMATION AND SHOW RULES

CLOSING DATE FOR ENTRIES is noon (P.D.T.), Wednesday, October 6, 2010 after which time entries cannot be accepted, canceled or changed, "except as provided for in Chapter 11, Section 6 of the Dog Show Rules".

MAIL ALL ENTRIES WITH ENTRY FEES TO: Lorie Abbott, 2144 Broadmoor St., Livermore, CA 94551. Acknowledgment of entries will be made as soon as possible after entries have closed. Should such acknowledgment not be received by the exhibitor within a reasonable time, please notify the Show Secretary at the above address or by telephone at (925) 294-8965 or Email lorie@abbadogs.com.

POST DATED AND RETURNED CHECKS do not constitute a valid entry fee. The Show Secretary will add a collection fee to the amount of each returned check. The returned check **MUST BE MADE GOOD** by cash or money order **BEFORE** the dog(s) will be allowed in the ring. Any person that issues a check that is returned for non-payment, will be required to pay a fine of \$25 per check and all items for which check or checks were issued shall then be paid by cash, money order or cashier's check.

CONDITIONAL, UNSIGNED, INCOMPLETE, or entries received without fees will not be accepted. **OWNERS ARE RESPONSIBLE** for errors on entry blanks and for entering the same dog twice. No refunds for duplicate entries.

ENTRIES NOT ON OFFICIAL AKC FORMS or photocopies of entry forms without rules and agreement on reverse side of Official AKC entry form are **NOT** acceptable.

CHANGES, ADDITIONS OR CORRECTIONS to entry forms must be received in writing prior to the close of entries. Those received by telephone are not acceptable.

TO BE ACCEPTABLE an entry must be submitted with required entry fee on an Official American Kennel Club entry form. Entries submitted in the form of telegrams or by telephone, cannot be accepted.

FACSIMILE MACHINE ENTRIES for this show will be accepted up to closing time. You will be billed through Paypal. A service fee of \$6 per dog will be charged. You must include the front and back of the entry form.. Fax number 925-292-0700.

SPECIAL DELIVERY & OVERNIGHT DELIVERY MAIL ADDRESS: Must be sent no signature required to Lorie Abbott, 2144 Broadmoor St., Livermore, CA 94551-1150.

ENTRY FEES SHALL NOT BE REFUNDED in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by the Judge, or barred from competition by action of the show committee, or because the dog is ineligible to compete due to being entered incorrectly. There is no refund of entry fee for duplicate entry or overpayment of entry fees. If because of riots, civil disturbances, fire, extreme and/or dangerous weather conditions, an Act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, strikes or any other acts beyond the control of the Club or Show Secretary it is impossible to open or complete the show, no refund of entry fee will be made.

AN ADMINSISTRATIVE FEE will be charged for all cancellations or changes made prior to closing of entries. Because of the cost of processing, no refunds under \$10 will be made.

ONLY DOGS THAT ARE ELIGIBLE to be shown under the American Kennel Club rules shall be allowed within the show precincts.

ALL DOGS SHALL BE kept on leash except when in the exercising or obedience ring.

THERE SHALL BE NO drilling nor intensive or corrective training of dogs on the show grounds or premises. **DOGS MUST BE READY FOR JUDGING.** The Club and its Show Secretary will not be responsible and are not obligated to furnish any service for notifying exhibitors or their agents of breed or class judging. Judges will not wait for any dog holding up a class. Owners or agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging ring.

DOGS NEED TO BE AT THE SHOW only at scheduled time of judging and may leave immediately thereafter, unless required for further judging.

THE CLUB reserves the right to substitute a prize of equal or greater value.

ALL TROPHIES must be claimed the day of the show. None will be mailed or otherwise distributed.

CLASS CASH PRIZES will be paid in the ring to the person showing the dog. Claims for prize money must be made in the ring before the judging is over and the Show Secretary Office is advised at once. The Show Secretary and Show giving club disclaim any liability for cash prizes after the judging of the class is over.

THE WELFARE OF AN EXHIBITOR'S CHILD is assumed to be the responsibility of the exhibitor. It is distinctly understood that exhibitors will exercise control and restraint over their children on the days of the shows.
