**Agility Show 'N' Go

The Show 'N' Go will begin 30 minutes after completion of regular licensed agility trials. This will be at approximately 2:00 pm on Friday and 3:00 pm on Saturday.

Friday: One ring with a Standard course, numbered, with all contacts, weaves and table.

Saturday: Two rings—Standard course, numbered, with all contacts, weaves and table. course

FAST style course offering A-frame, Teeter and weave poles. This course will not be numbered.

Entry fee: \$8 per run; \$15 for two runs, same dog only.

Each dog is limited to a maximum of 4 runs (\$30)

Each run is limited to 60 seconds

Match is limited to a total of 200 runs

Pre-entries accepted through mail received by Wednesday, September 1, 2010. After this date entry must be made at the show site. Sign up at the score table with Karin Parker or Pam Hetrick.

Directions to Dixon Fairgrounds

Both rings will on the South Lawn, on grass and measure 100' x 120'. Bring shade.

Directions:

From I-80 west in Dixon, take 113 South towards Dixon.

From I-80 east, take the Dixon Ave/A Street exit and go right on A Street. Turn right on First Street. The fairgrounds are 3 blocks south on your left side. Go past the office/main entrance drive and turn left into the south end of the fairgrounds.

- ◆ Dogs must be at least 1 year of age to enter
- ◆ Any trained dog may enter. Dogs do not need to be entered in Napa Valley DTC regular licensed agility trials
- ◆ Toys & clickers are allowed in the ring
- ◆ Food is NOT allowed in the ring
- ◆ Maximum course time will be strictly enforced
- ◆ No harsh verbal or physical corrections allowed
- ◆ Excusal for dogs fouling the ring PLUS \$10 clean up fee
- ◆ Entry fees will not be refunded if the dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by action of the trial committee. If, because of riots, civil disturbances, or other acts beyond the control of management it is impossible to open or complete the match, no refund of entry fees will be made
- ◆ No bitches in season. No refunds for bitches in season.

The organizing committee may refuse entry for any reason. There will be no refunds for entries withdrawn after the closing date or in the event a dog and/or handler are dismissed from the event, regardless of the reason for dismissal. It is expressly understood that entrants alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs, children, or guests. Any entrant whose dogs, children, or guests create unnecessary disturbances or engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior, may at the discretion of the organizing committee, be asked to remove the offending dogs, children, or guests from the event grounds. No refund of fees will be made in such a case. Judge and/or gate steward may excuse any entrant for any infractions with NO REFUNDS.

We will allow day of match entries until the match begins. Walk through will begin 30 minutes after completion of regular judging. This will be at approximately 2:00 pm on Friday and 3:00 pm on Saturday.

Assumption of Risk

- 1. Assumption of Risk:** The undersigned is aware of the inherent risks of injury, death, and property damage to the undersigned, to his or her dog(s) that are involved in the recreational activity of canine agility, including without limitations, risks due to dog bite, the use of agility equipment, or infectious disease. The undersigned is aware of the risks of injury, death, and property damage that may result from, among other causes, the active or passive negligence of management. The undersigned is voluntarily engaging in dog agility as a recreational activity with the knowledge of the risks of injury, death, and property damage that may result from participation in dog agility.
- 2. Release of Liability** The undersigned releases management from all liability to the undersigned, the "undersigned" representatives, guardians, successors, assigns, heirs, and next of kin for all liability, claims, damage, or demands for personal injury, death, or property damage, to the undersigned or the undersigned's dog(s), arising from or related to this agreement. This release includes, without limitation, any personal injury, death, or property damage caused by the active or passive negligence of management. The undersigned bears sole responsibility for any loss.
- 3. Knowing and Voluntary Execution** the undersigned acknowledges that he or she has carefully read this agreement, understands its contents, and understands that this agreement includes an assumption of risk of the management negligence and a release of their liability. The undersigned acknowledges that management are materially relying on this waiver in allowing the undersigned to participate in this dog agility event.
- 4. I also state my dog(s) is/are not aggressive towards people or other dogs** and that I understand I alone am responsible for the behavior of my dog(s), that any dog, which is out of control, creates an unnecessary disturbance or engages in unsafe or disruptive behavior, may at the discretion of the organizing committee, be expelled from the event grounds with NO REFUNDS.
