Set Ups, Check In, Start Times, Walk Through

Preliminary running order contingent on move-up entries not yet received. Exhibitors shall be provided armbands or stickers indicating their dog's running order number for this trial. Per AKC rules, the move up deadline is 6 pm on Monday, August 30, 2010. Absolutely no move ups for Friday will be allowed after this time and date. Move ups for Saturday, Sunday and Monday must be given to the Trial Secretary, at the show site, in writing within 15 minutes of the last dog completing the course the day prior.

Novice B/A Standard, JWW and FAST classes will run together by jump heights with division B running before division A. Excellent B/A Standard, JWW and FAST classes will run together by jump heights with division B running before division A. The preferred classes will

run intermingled with the regular classes by height. Each class will be briefed separately. Lunch breaks will be at the Judge's discretion. A warm-up area, consisting of a regulation agility jump will be provided for all exhibitors.

Check in will begin each day at 7:00 am. Armbands may be picked up at the score table each morning.

Judging will begin each morning at 8:00 am.

Walk through will begin as soon as the Judge has approved the course. This will be at approximately 7:30 am each day. Open and Novice and FAST: all heights will walk the course together prior to their class being judged. Excellent Standard and JWW will be split into two groups as follows:

Small Dogs: 4" - 16"

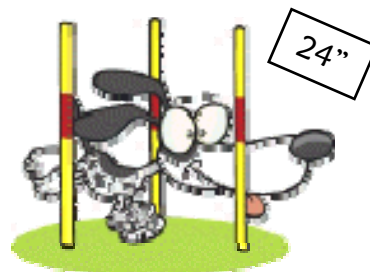
Big Dogs: 20" - 26"

The order will be walk run, walk run, etc. Each group will walk immediately before they run.

Unless you have a conflict, i.e. showing in another ring or working, you **MUST** walk with your group.

Set Ups No exhibitor set ups before 3 pm on Thursday unless you are part of the set up crew.

RV Parking Stop by the score table anytime after 3 pm on Thursday to pick up your parking pass.



No set ups or marking off space around the rings before 2 pm.

Directions: From I-80 west in Dixon, take 113 South towards Dixon.

From I-80 east, take the Dixon Ave/A Street exit and go right on A Street. Turn right on First Street. The fairgrounds are 3 blocks south on your left side. Go past the office/main entrance drive and turn left into the south end of the fairgrounds.

Both rings will be on the South Lawn on grass and will measure 100' x 120'. Bring your own shade.

No Food Vendor on site this weekend. Be prepared to bring your lunch.

All About the Height Cards

All dogs, regardless of jump height, who are under two years of age and do not have a temporary height card or are over two years of age and do not have a permanent height card must be measured

prior to their first run of the weekend. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to ensure their dog is measured before their first run. Measurement of dogs will take place near the score table each day

for 10 minutes at the top of each hour. If you need to be measured "raise the flag". Cindy Macklin or Kathie Leggett will measure.

Directions: Take I-80 towards Sacramento. Take 113 north towards Woodland. Take the first exit (Hutchison Drive) and bear right (east) on Hutchison Drive. Turn right at the first stop light (LaRue Road). Follow LaRue Road to the first right turn (Garrod Drive). Follow Garrod Drive to the stop sign. After stopping, proceed directly ahead. The client parking lot entrance is on your right. Client parking is free as long as you park in a designated patient parking space. Client parking cannot accommodate vehicles that require more space than a passenger car. There are three different reception stations and it is important to come to the station mentioned when you made your appointment. Reception station 3 is in the building on your left as you drive toward the parking lot and reception stations 1 and 2 are in the main hospital building which is to the west of the parking lot. Drive time approximately 15 minutes.

Any entrant whose dogs, children, or guests create unnecessary disturbances or engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior, may at the discretion of the organizing committee, be asked to remove the offending dogs, children, or guests from the event grounds. No refund of fees will be made in such a case. Judge and/or gate steward may excuse any entrant for any infractions with NO REFUNDS.

We will allow day of match entries until the match begins. Walk through will begin 30 minutes after completion of regular judging. This will be at approximately 2:00 pm on Friday and 3:00 pm on Saturday.

Assumption of Risk

1. Assumption of Risk: The undersigned is aware of the inherent risks of injury, death, and property damage to the undersigned, to his or her dog(s) that are involved in the recreational activity of canine agility, including without limitations, risks due to dog bite, the use of agility equipment, or infectious disease. The undersigned is aware of the risks of injury, death, and property damage that may result from, among other causes, the active or passive negligence of management. The undersigned is voluntarily engaging in dog agility as a recreational activity with the knowledge of the risks of injury, death, and property damage that may result from participation in dog agility.

2. Release of Liability The undersigned releases management from all liability to the undersigned, the "undersigned" representatives, guardians, successors, assigns, heirs, and next of kin for all liability, claims, damage, or demands for personal injury, death, or property damage, to the undersigned or the undersigned's dog(s), arising from or related to this agreement. This release includes, without limitation, any personal injury, death, or property damage caused by the active or passive negligence of management. The undersigned bears sole responsibility for any loss.

3. Knowing and Voluntary Execution the undersigned acknowledges that he or she has carefully read this agreement, understands its contents, and understands that this agreement includes an assumption of risk of the management negligence and a release of their liability. The undersigned acknowledges that management are materially relying on this waiver in allowing the undersigned to participate in this dog agility event.

4. I also state my dog(s) is/are not aggressive towards people or other dogs and that I understand I alone am responsible for the behavior of my dog(s), that any dog, which is out of control, creates an unnecessary disturbance or engages in unsafe or disruptive behavior, may at the discretion of the organizing committee, be expelled from the event grounds with NO REFUNDS.
