## Set Ups, Check In, Start Times, Walk Through

### Preliminary running

order contingent on move-up entries not yet received, or when adding wait-listed entries after closing. Exhibitors shall be provided armbands or stickers indicating their dog's running order number for this trial. Per AKC rules, the move up deadline is 6 pm on Monday, July 14, 2014. Absolutely no move ups for Saturday will be allowed after this time and date. Move ups for Sunday and Monday must be given to the Trial Secretary, at the show site, in writing within 15 minutes of the last dog completing the course on Saturday.

Novice B/A Standard, JWW and FAST classes will run together by jump heights with division B running before division A. Excellent/Master Standard, JWW and FAST classes will run together by jump heights with Master running before Excellent.

The preferred classes will run intermingled with the regular classes by height. Each class will be briefed separately. Lunch breaks will be at the Judge's discretion. A warm-up area, consisting of a regulation agility jump will be provided for all exhibitors.

**Check in** will begin each morning at 7:30 am. Armbands may be picked up at the score table each day.

**Judging will begin** Saturday, Sunday and Monday at 8:30 am. See page 4 for B-Match times.

**Walk through** will begin as soon as the Judges have approved the courses. This will be at approximately 8:00 am each day. Open and Novice Standard, JWW & FAST: all heights will walk the course together prior to their class being judged.

See page two for Excellent/Master Standard, JWW

and FAST and T2B walk through directions. The order will be walk/run etc.

Unless you have a conflict, i.e. showing in the other agility ring or in Barn Hunt or working you **MUST** walk with your group.

If you *think* there is a possibility you will miss your scheduled walk through due to a conflict then plan to walk with an earlier group. If walking with an earlier group you may NOT walk again with your group.

**Set Ups** No exhibitor set ups before noon on Friday unless you are part of the set up crew.

**Directions:** From North or South on 101 take the exit 691 toward Fernbridge/Ferndale. Left onto CA-211, go over the bridge and continue 5 miles. Right on Van Ness Ave. Left on 5th St.

The rings will be outdoors on grass and measure 100' x 100'. Bring shade.

**Food and beverages** will be available for purchase on the show site.

## All About the Height Cards

All dogs, regardless of jump height, who are under two years of age and do not have a temporary height card or are over two years of age and do not have a permanent height card must be measured

prior to their first run of the weekend. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to ensure their dog is measured before their first run. Measurement of dogs will take place near the score table throughout the

day when Beverly Morgan Lewis and Jan Skurzynski are not otherwise occupied. Measurement will "count" toward dog's permanent height card.

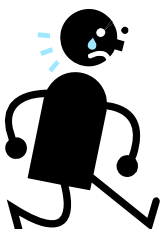

## Excellent Walk Split

Dogs will be judged from the lowest armband number in each class to the highest armband number in each class.

The order will be walk/run, walk/run etc. by group.

Master/Excellent Standard and JWW: will be split into four groups as follows:



- 4/8/12 (39 on largest day)
- 16 (35 on largest day)
- 20 (42 on largest day)
- 24/26 (15 on largest day)

MASTER/Excellent FAST and T2B: will be split into two groups as follows:

4/8/12/16 (40 on largest day)

20/24/26 (40 on largest)

If you think there is a possibility you will miss your scheduled walk through due to a conflict then plan to walk with an earlier group. If walking with an earlier group you may NOT walk again with your group.

## Check In At The Gate

Be sure to check in *before* walking your course. The Scribe needs to verify the order of the scribe sheets for absent and conflict dogs. This is to ensure *your* score is on the correct sheet.

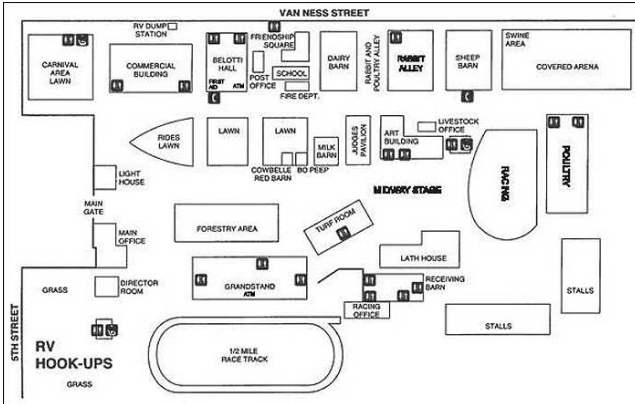

## Ring Location

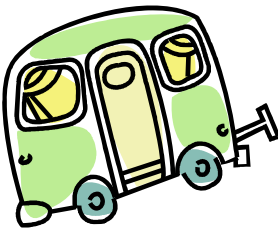
The rings will be located on the Soccer Field.

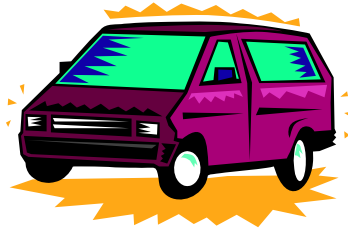
Before parking, pitching your tent etc. phone Gail. Gail has the fairgrounds instructions as to available spaces.

## Day Parking Unloading/Loading

Parking, while space is available will be near the rings. Overflow parking will be along Van Ness Ave and throughout the main fairgrounds

Per the AKC Agility Trial Manual, no moving vehicles or generator are allowed within 50' of an active ring.

From 30 minutes prior to judging until after the last dog of the day has run and is safely confined, no exhibitor or vendor shall drive in any area that has been cordoned off by tape, cones, etc.

## Course Maps

Once the Judges arrive at the show site hard copies of the course maps are placed in one of the three black file boxes labeled either Master, Open or Novice. A copy of each map is posted in the score posting notebooks. The file boxes and score posting notebooks are located at the score table. Copies of the course maps are based on entry numbers so please DO NOT take a map unless you are actually in that class.

Exhibitors should consider bringing with them to the show tracing paper and a pencil. If the maps are gone they can trace a map from the posted copy.

Lastly, DO NOT remove the map posted in the notebooks.

## Scores & Awards

The score posting books will be located near the main score table—this will be near Lorie's trailer and black truck. The ribbons and first place prizes will be located in the Club Area—this will be near the worker raffle. There will be a clipboard at the awards table. If the ribbon labels are ready the daily awards form, located on the front of the clipboard, will be initialed next to that class. All scores MUST be verified by the judge BEFORE ribbons can be released. You need to be patient, often all dogs within a height class are not scored at the same time due to ring conflicts.

If you have any questions regarding your score ask the main score table. Lorie, Pam and Dave can answer your question. If we do not know the answer will find out. Please do not ask the Scribe or Timer your score or time. They are busy scoring the next dog.

## I Need To Move Up

### Day to Day Move Up

The PINK move up forms are located on a clip board at the by the score posting books.

Step 1: Complete the form

Step 2: Place in the plastic basket used to collect scribe sheets. This will be a basket near the stairs.

Move ups for Sunday must be given to the Trial Secretary, at the show site, in writing within 15 minutes of the last dog completing the course on Saturday.

Permission has been granted by the Barn Hunt Association, LLC for the holding of these fun runs under BHA Rules and Regulations.

**Fun Runs on Friday:** Pre-entry is encouraged. Day of sign ups will be taken by Lorie Abbott until entry limit has been reached. Day of entries will run last. Bring **exact** money or check payable to Lorie Abbott

**Dogs will be staged into 4 time groups:**

**11 am noon 1 pm 2 pm**

Handlers with multiple dogs running two times will be staged into multiple time groups

Handlers with one dog running two times will be staged into the same time group

Course will be covered and enclosed with fencing.

No scoring or prizes will be offered. Scores will not count toward titles.

Event is open to all dogs. BHA registration number is not required.

All dogs must be on a short leash except while showing and under control while on the grounds.

Bitches in season are eligible for entry but will be required to be kept separate from all other dogs and will run last.

Any dog that fouls the arena in any way i.e. urinates, defecates, vomits will be immediately excused.

## Friday afternoon B-Match

**\$8/\$7 per dog. \$29 for four runs, same dog only. Match will begin at 2:00 pm**

Day of sign ups will begin at 1:00 pm. See Pat White at the score table. Day of sign ups will end at 2:00 pm or when entry limit of 400 runs has been reached. Bring exact money or check payable to Lorie Abbott.

Classes offered: Standard and FAST. One course will be set in each ring. You may run the numbered course or your own pattern. No scoring or prizes will be offered. Walk through will begin as soon as the course is set, approximately 1:30 pm. We do not care in which ring you run.

Dogs do not need to be entered in the regular trials. Dogs may be entered multiple times in the same class with a maximum of 4 runs per dog. Each run will be a maximum of 60 seconds.

Toys and clickers are allowed in the ring. Food is not allowed in the ring. Maximum course time will be strictly enforced. No harsh verbal or physical corrections allowed. Excusal for dog fouling the ring.

When checking in, you will receive a ticket for each round purchased for each dog. The tickets are color coded and labeled. The ticket must be turned into the gate steward before your turn.

Round 3—Orange                Round 4—Pink

Rings will run in the following order:

                          FAST Type Ring: 20
- Round 2:            Standard Ring 20.

- Round 3:            Standard Ring: All heights *except 20*  
                          FAST Type Ring: 20
- Round 4:            Standard Ring 20.  
                          FAST Type Ring: All heights *except 20*

It is the exhibitor's responsibility to follow these instructions, listen for announcements of height changes and get in line when their height is called.

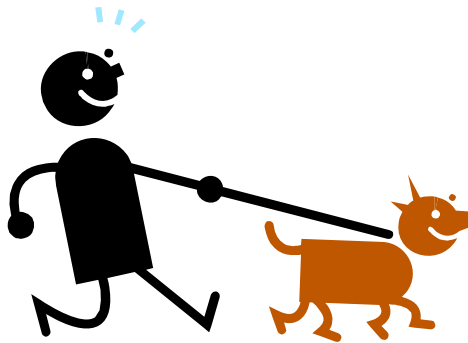

## I have a conflict

Every effort will be made to accommodate legitimate conflicts, however, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to check in, mark their dogs as a conflict if necessary and walk courses when assigned. Conflicts will be resolved based on the Judge's instructions.

Examples of legitimate conflict: working or running in the other agility ring or in barn hunt, dogs in the same height class with the same handler too close together in run order.

Examples of illegitimate conflicts: handler late to show site, handler not paying attention and missed their run, handler moving dog so they can run before or after a particular dog or to not run before or after a particular dog. These are considered by AKC to be personal emergencies and not conflicts.

When checking in exhibitors may mark their dogs with a C for conflict. Exhibitors may NOT move their own dogs at the gate. Moves at the gate can only be made one of the following persons:

Any Judge of record for this weekend's event, Gate Steward assigned to that class, Crew Chief

Designated Others: Lorie Abbott, David Connet, Pam Hetrick, Beverly Morgan Lewis.

If you have a legitimate conflict speak with one of these people and they will move your dog.
